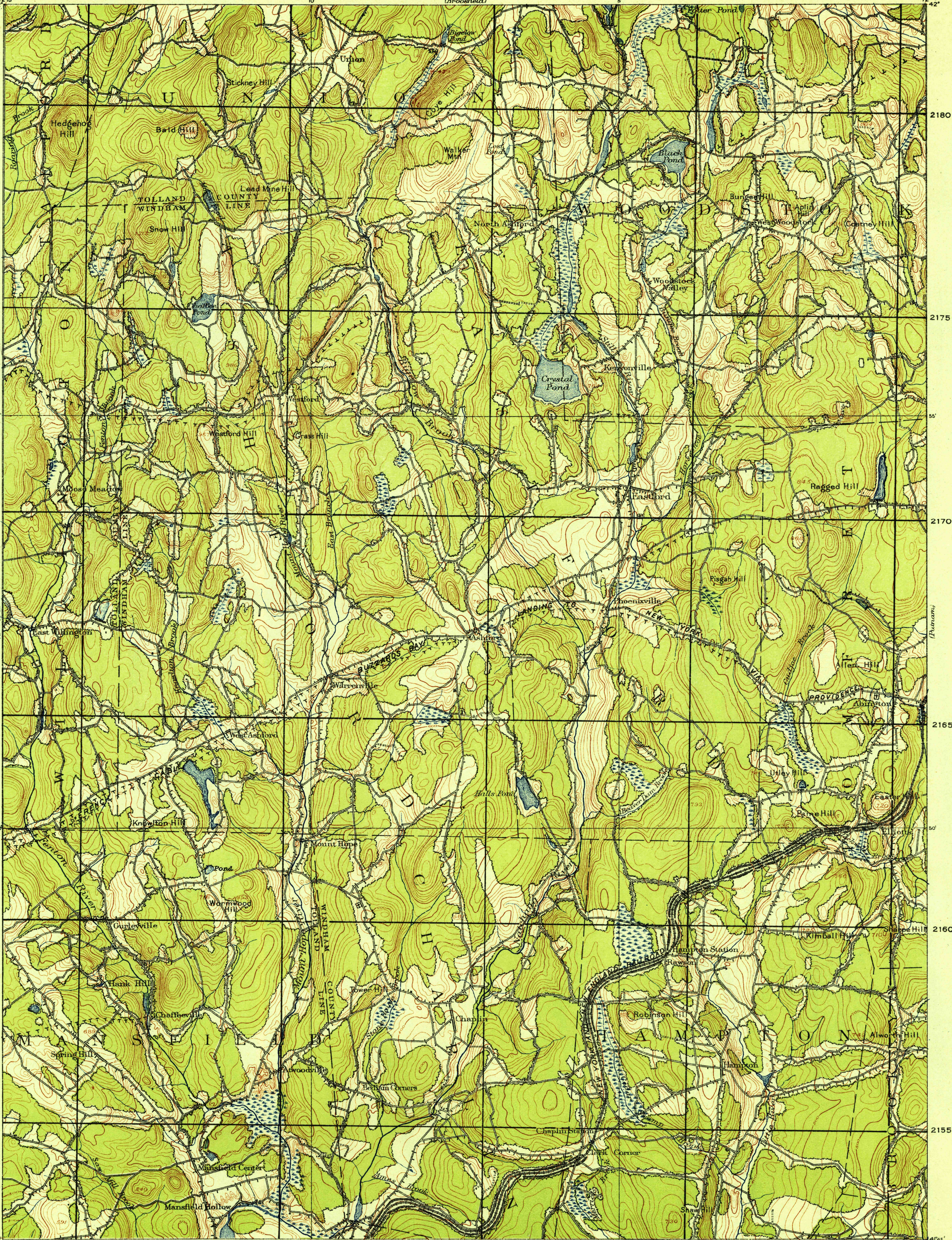
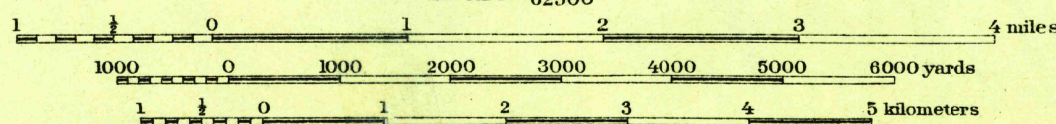

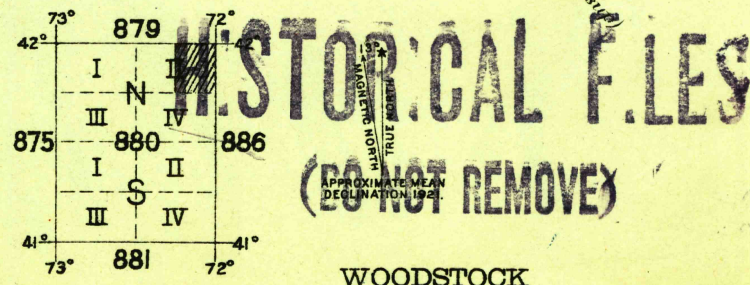


Contour Interval 20 feet
