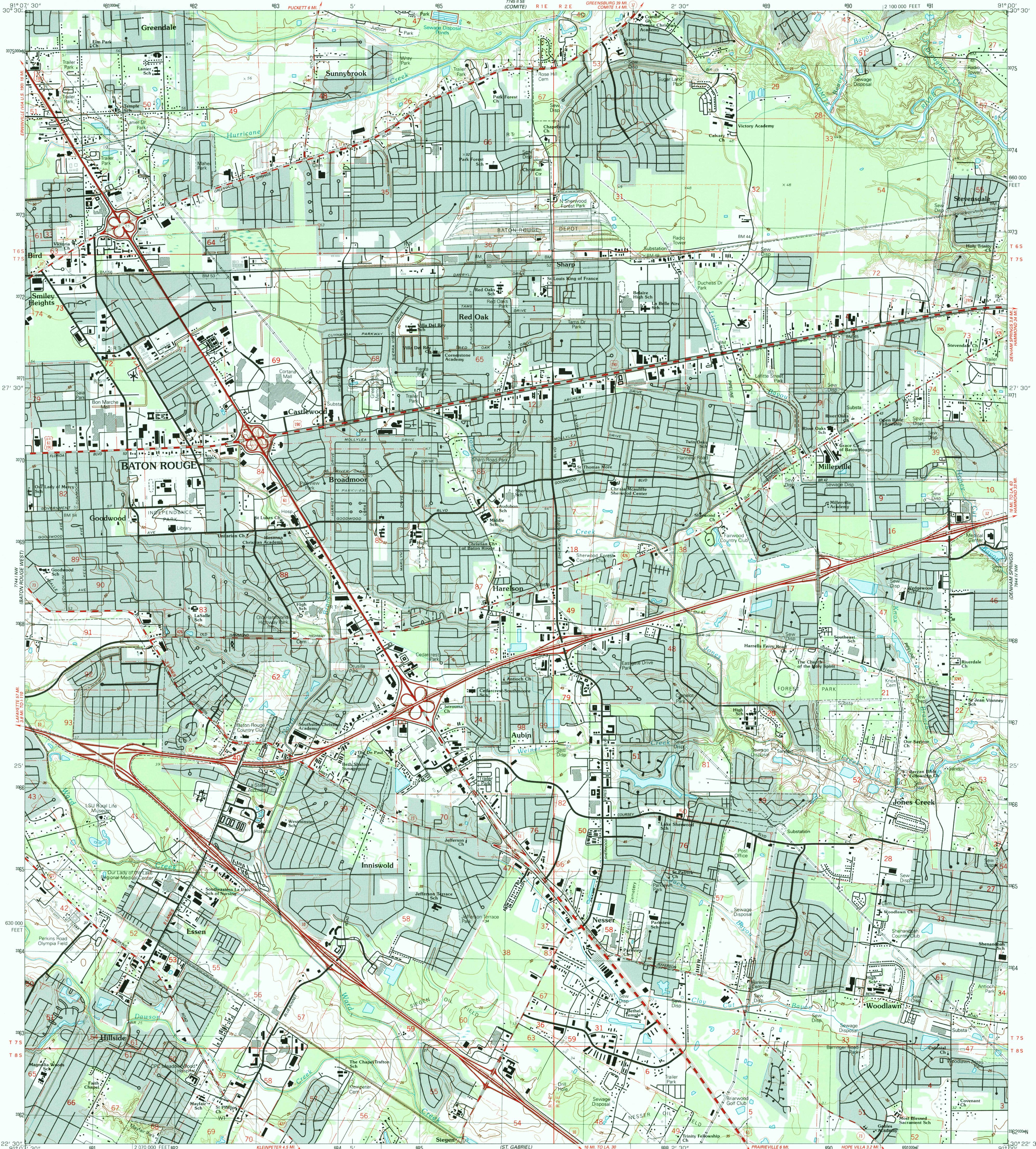


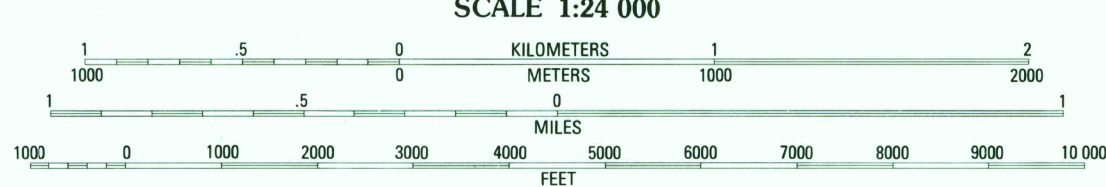

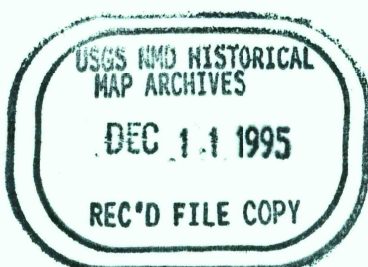
UTM GRID AND 1992 MAGNETIC NORTH
