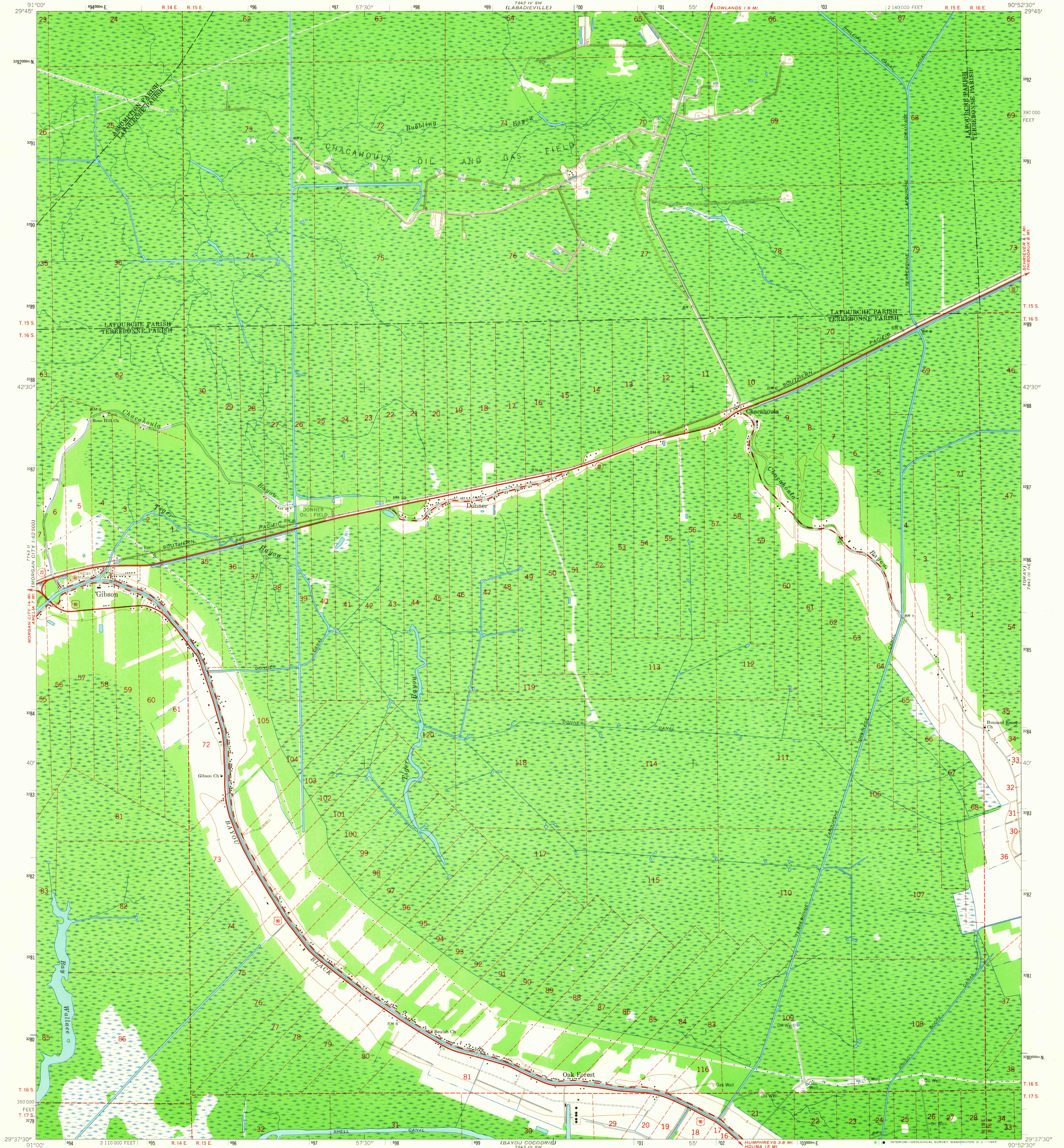

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

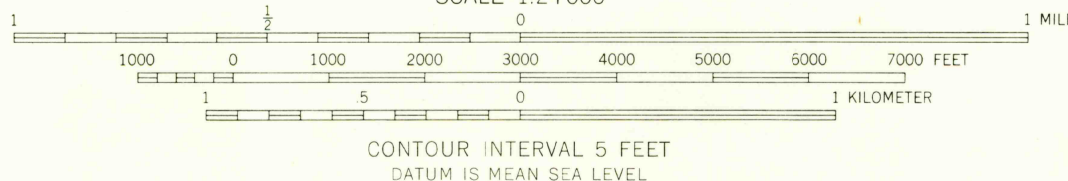
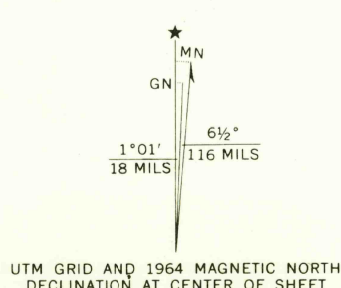
10,000-foot grid based on Louisiana coordinate system, south zone
