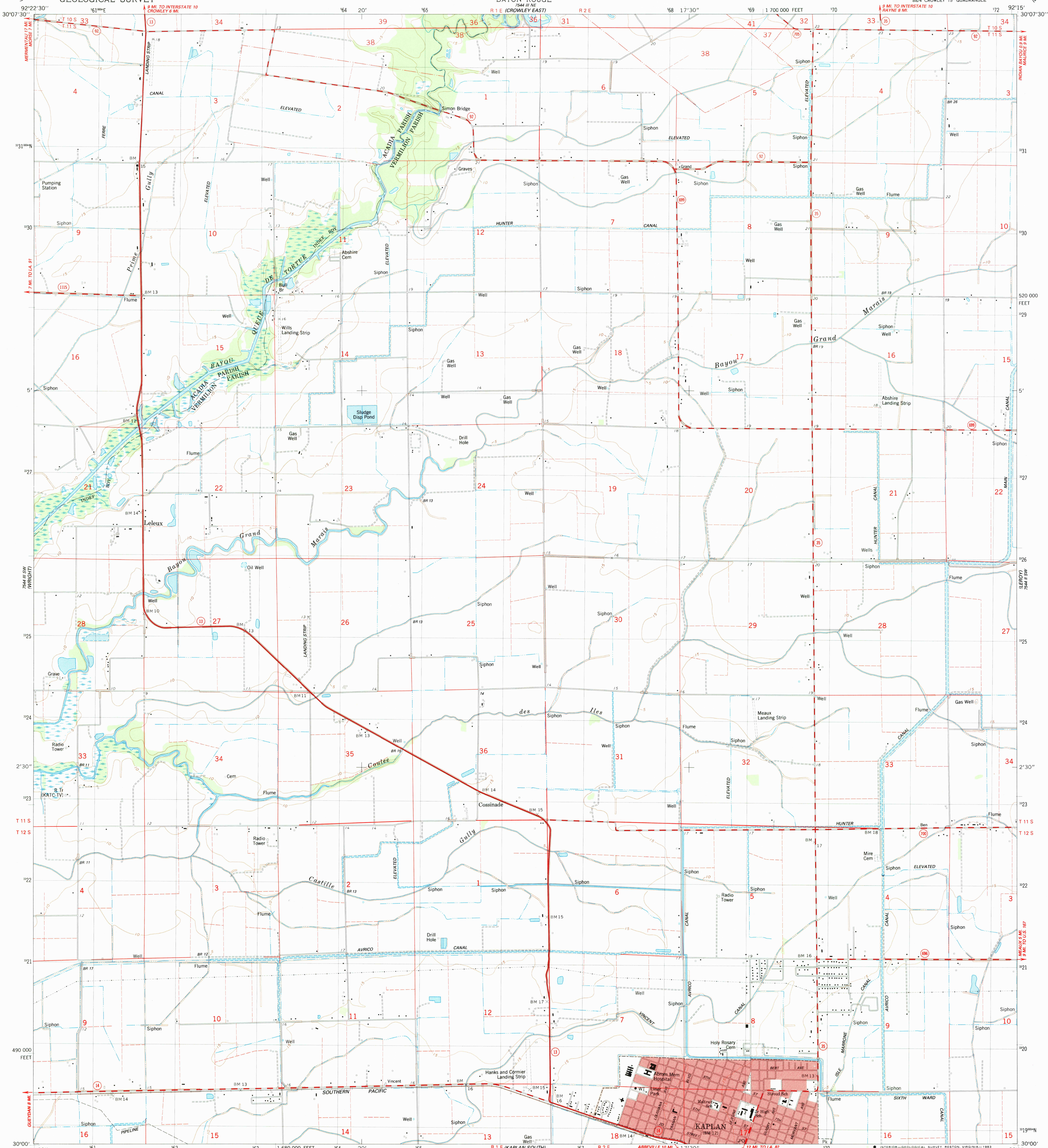

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Louisiana coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic)

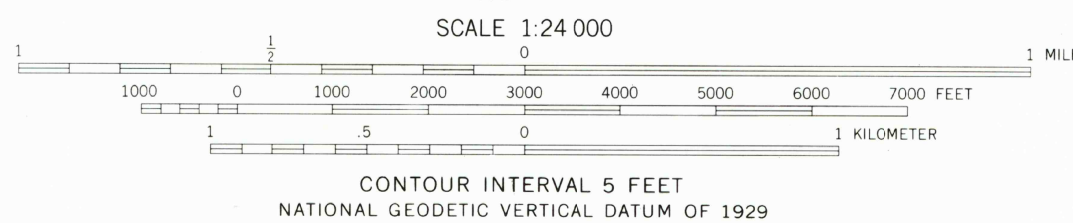
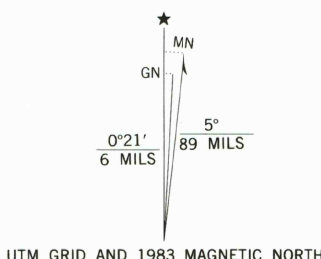
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 15

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 19 meters south and 13 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

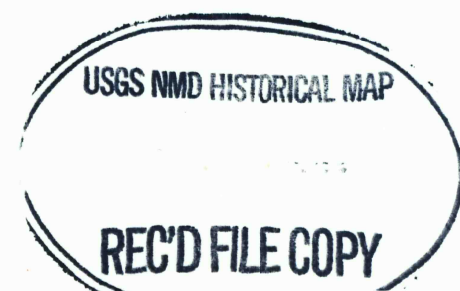
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
