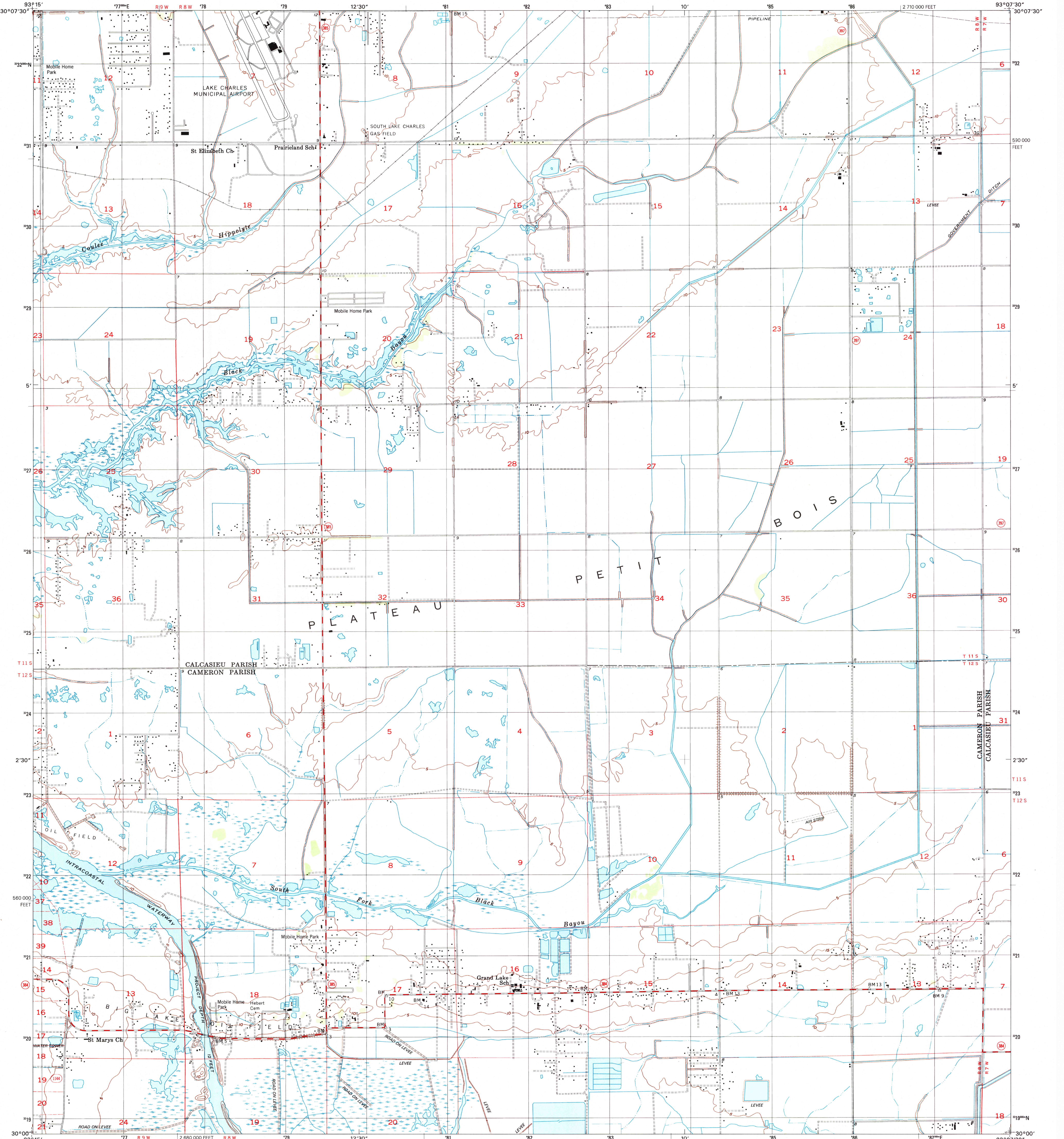

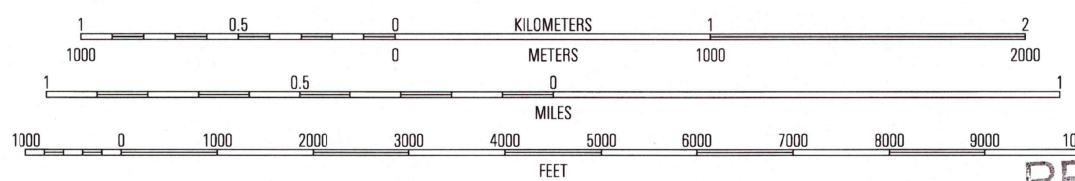
North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83). Projection and
