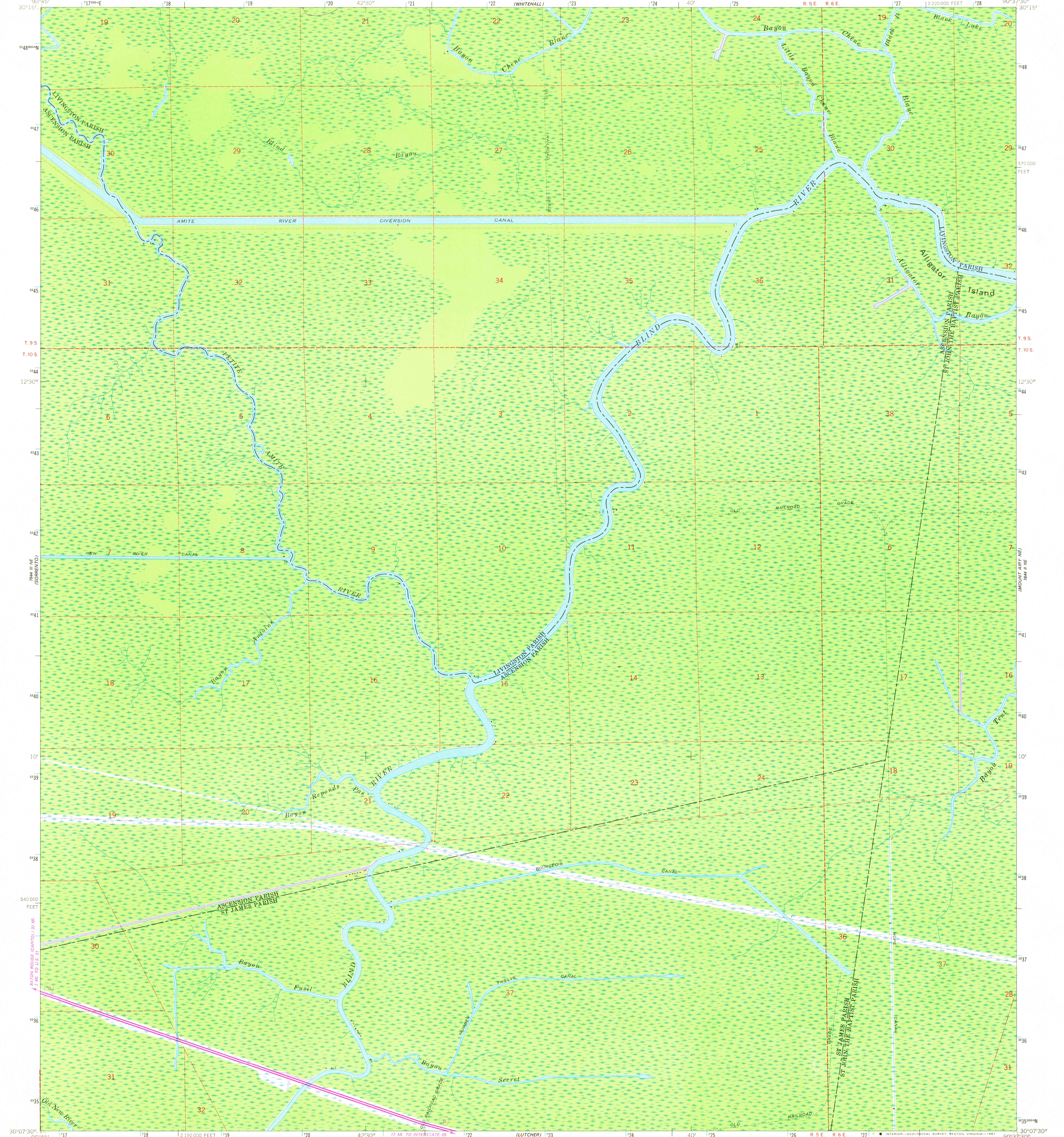

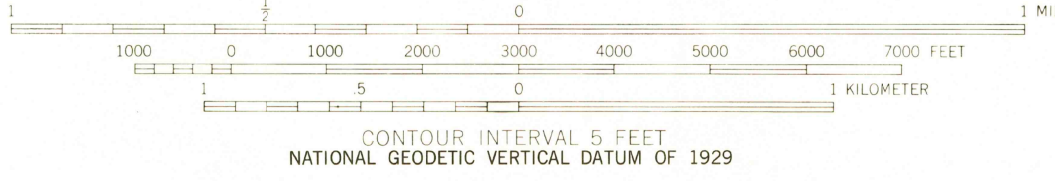
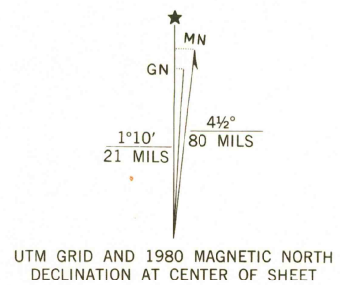
MOUNT AIRY NW QUADRANGLE
