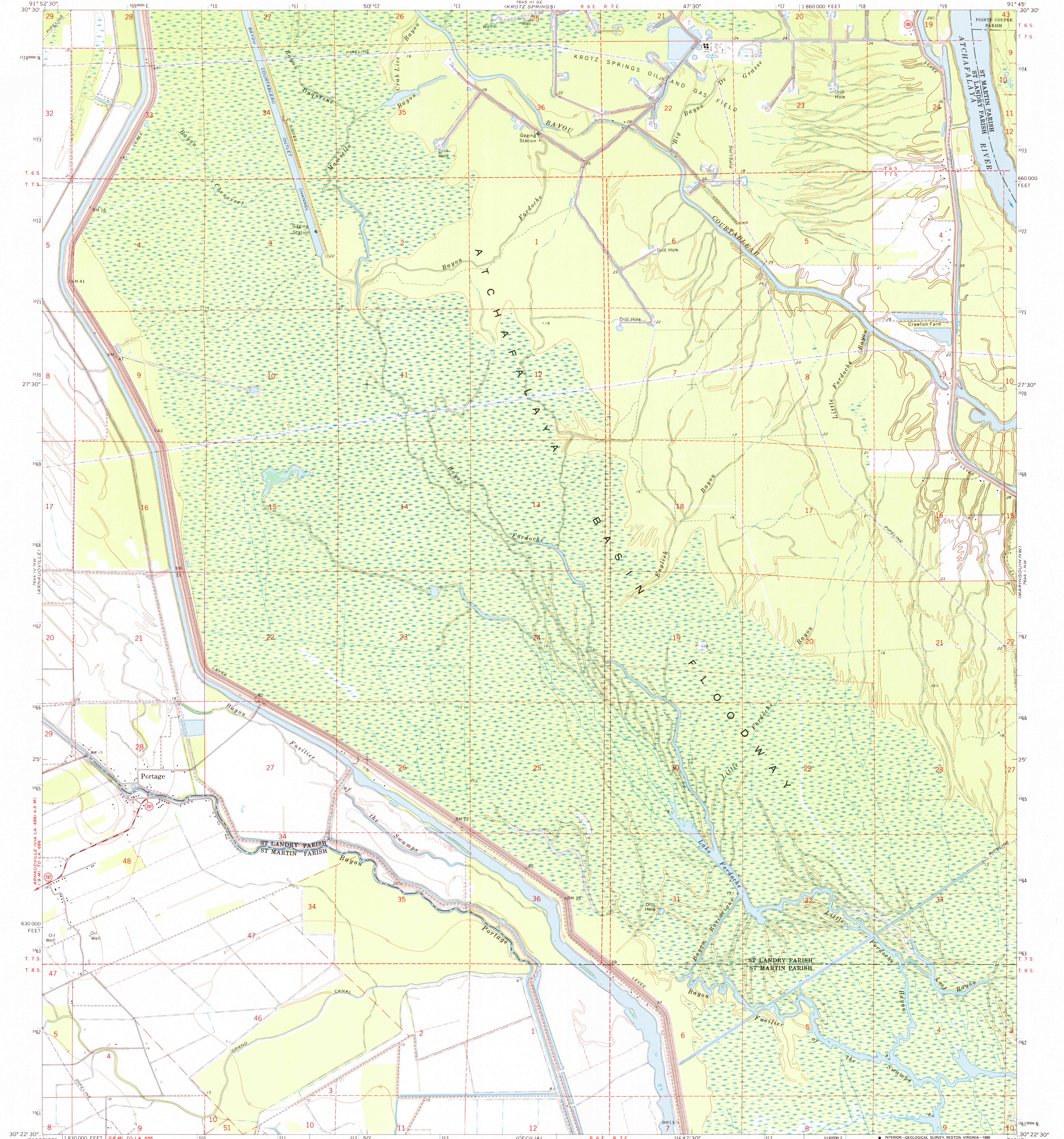

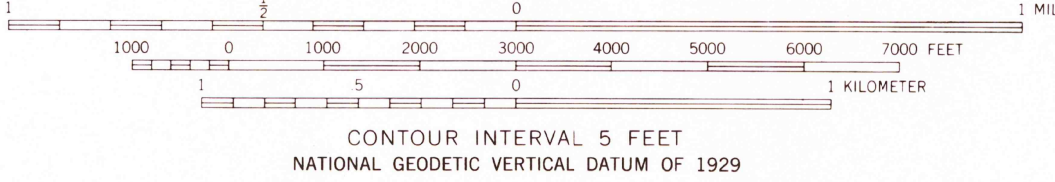
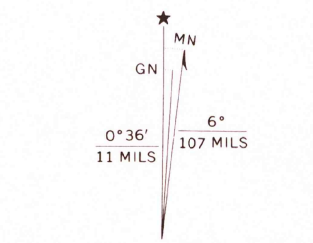

Planimetry by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1969. Topography by planetable surveys 1970

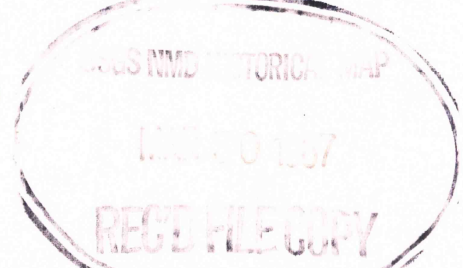

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 18 meters south and 12 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
