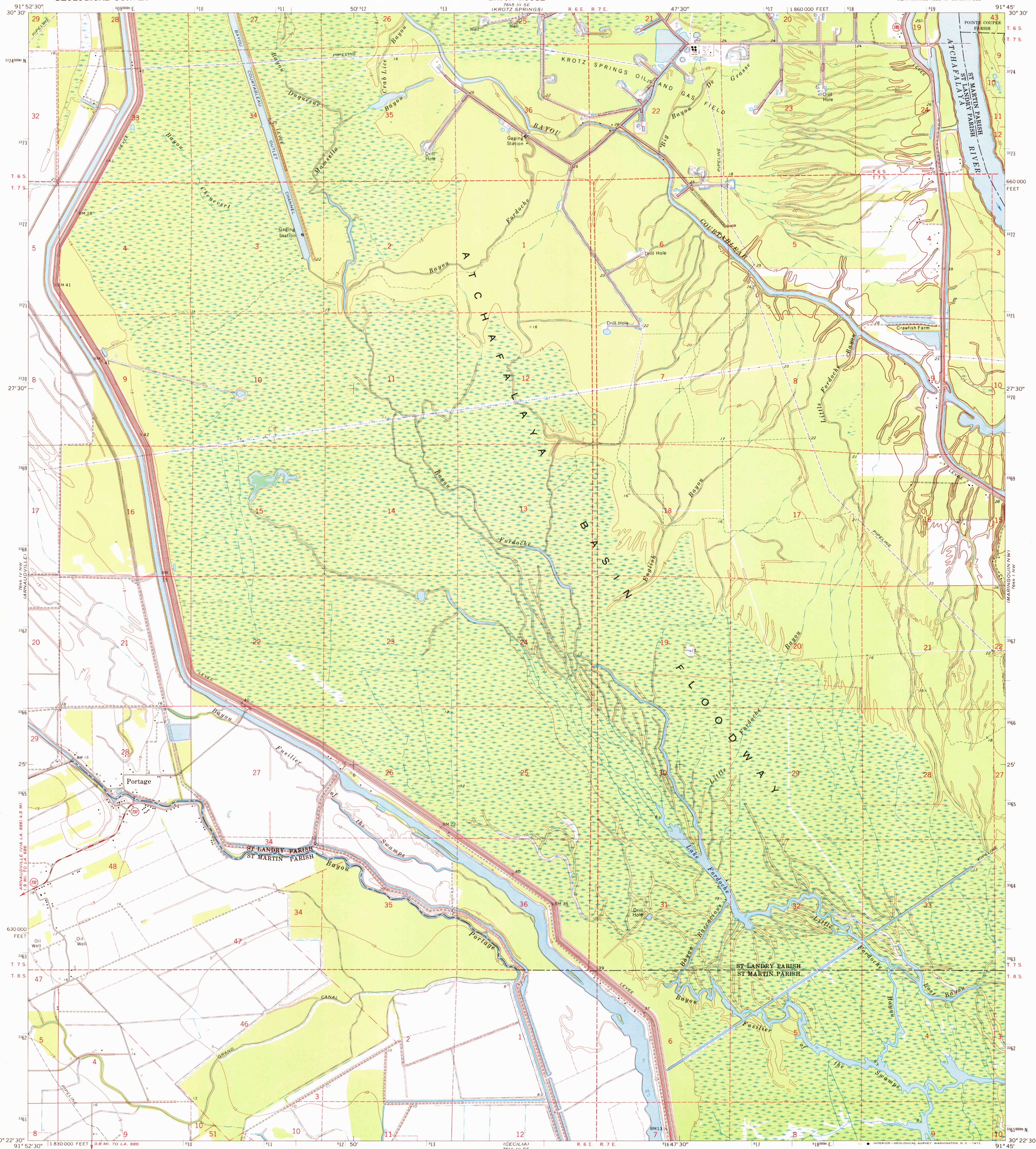




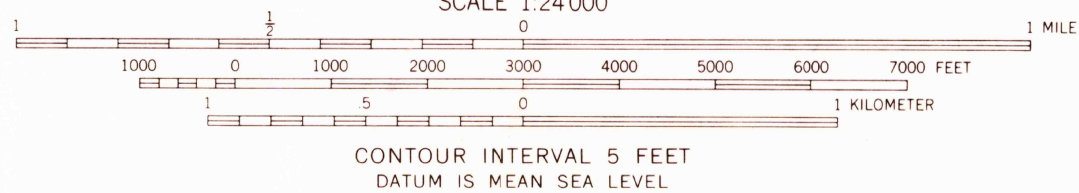
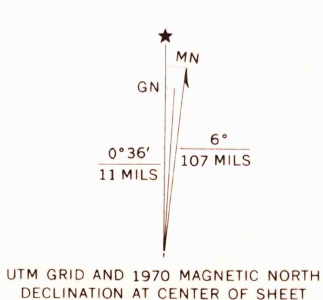
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Planimetry by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1969. Topography by planetable surveys 1970
