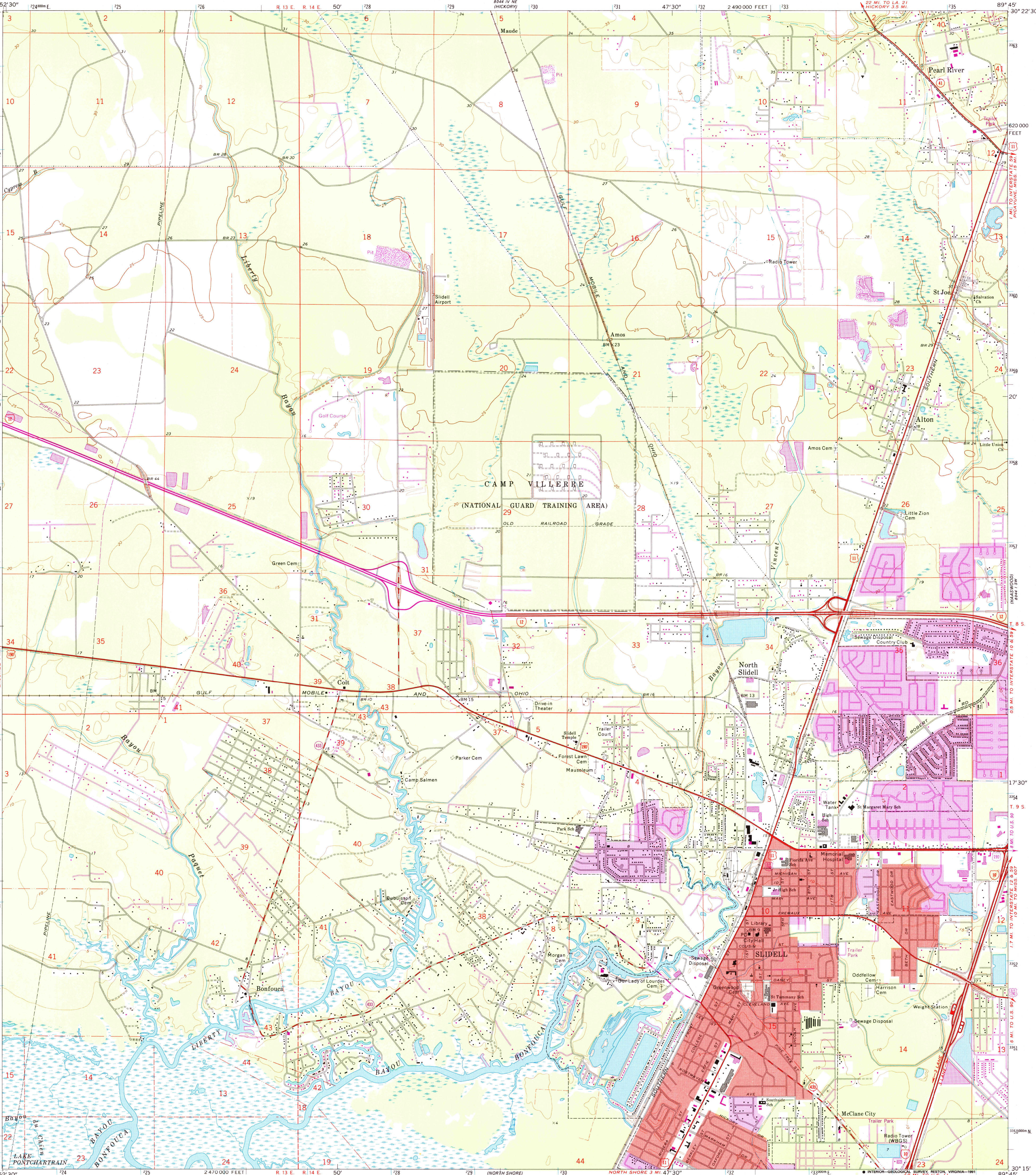

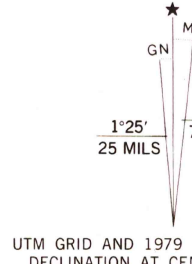
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Louisiana coordinate system, south zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 18 meters south and 7 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE TWO DATUMS IS VARIABLE

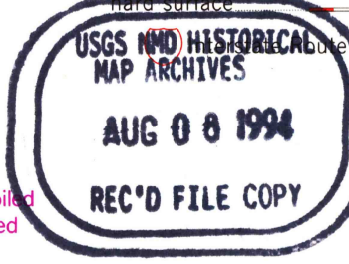
SHORELINE SHOWN REPRESENTS THE APPROXIMATE LINE OF MEAN HIGH WATER
