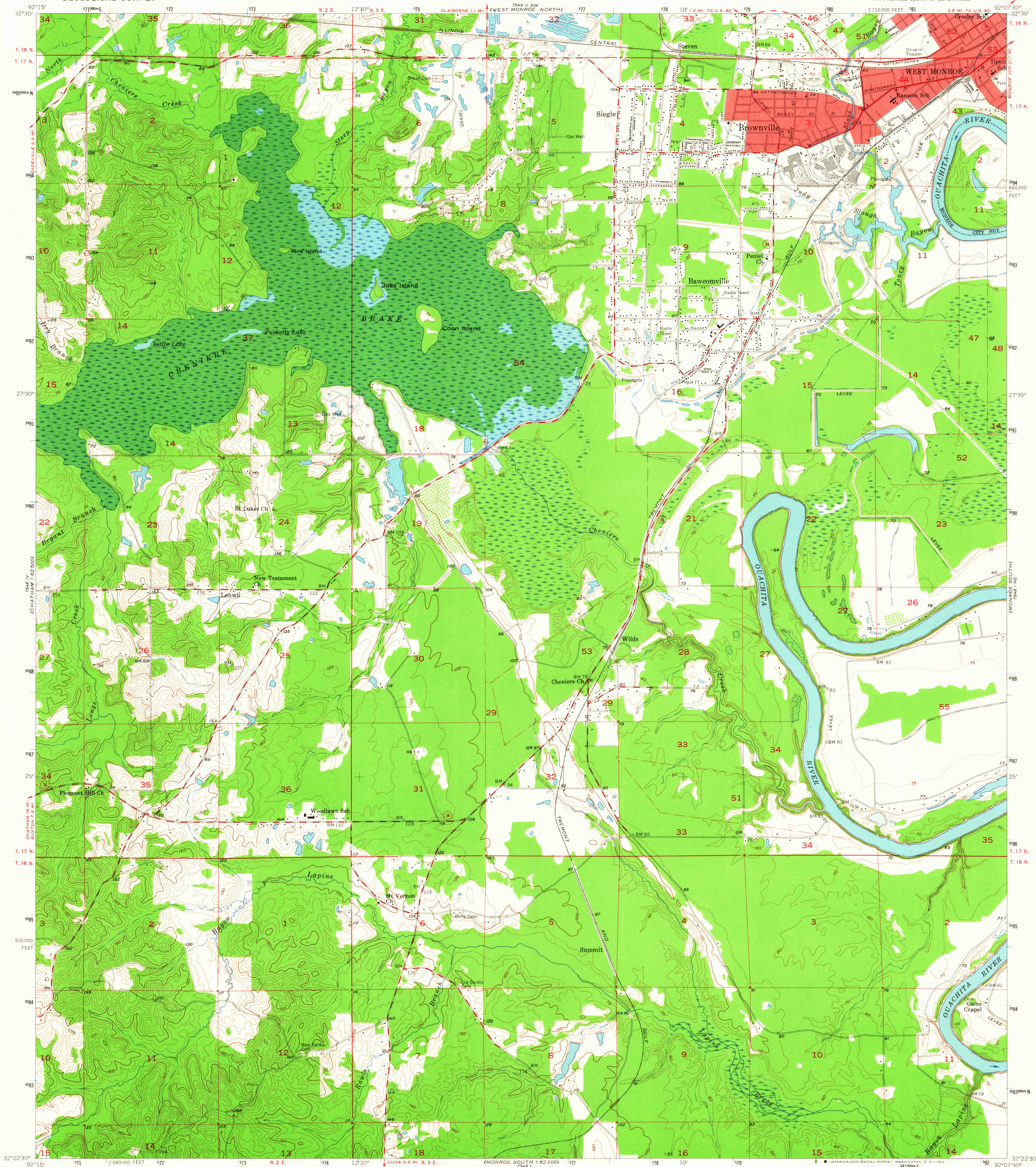

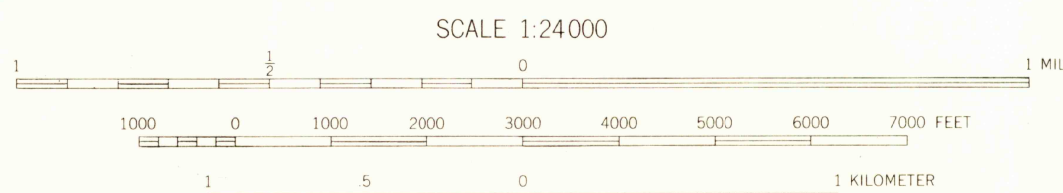
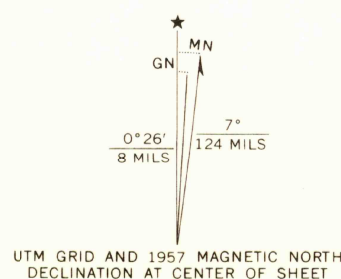
10,000-foot grid based on Louisiana coordinate system, north zone
