Army Engineer District, New Orleans, Corps of Engineers, in April 1950 and May 1956 respectively. The remaining elevations are from survey 1935-36. Elevations in Lake Maurepas from U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey Chart No. 1269, expressed in feet mean sea level.
