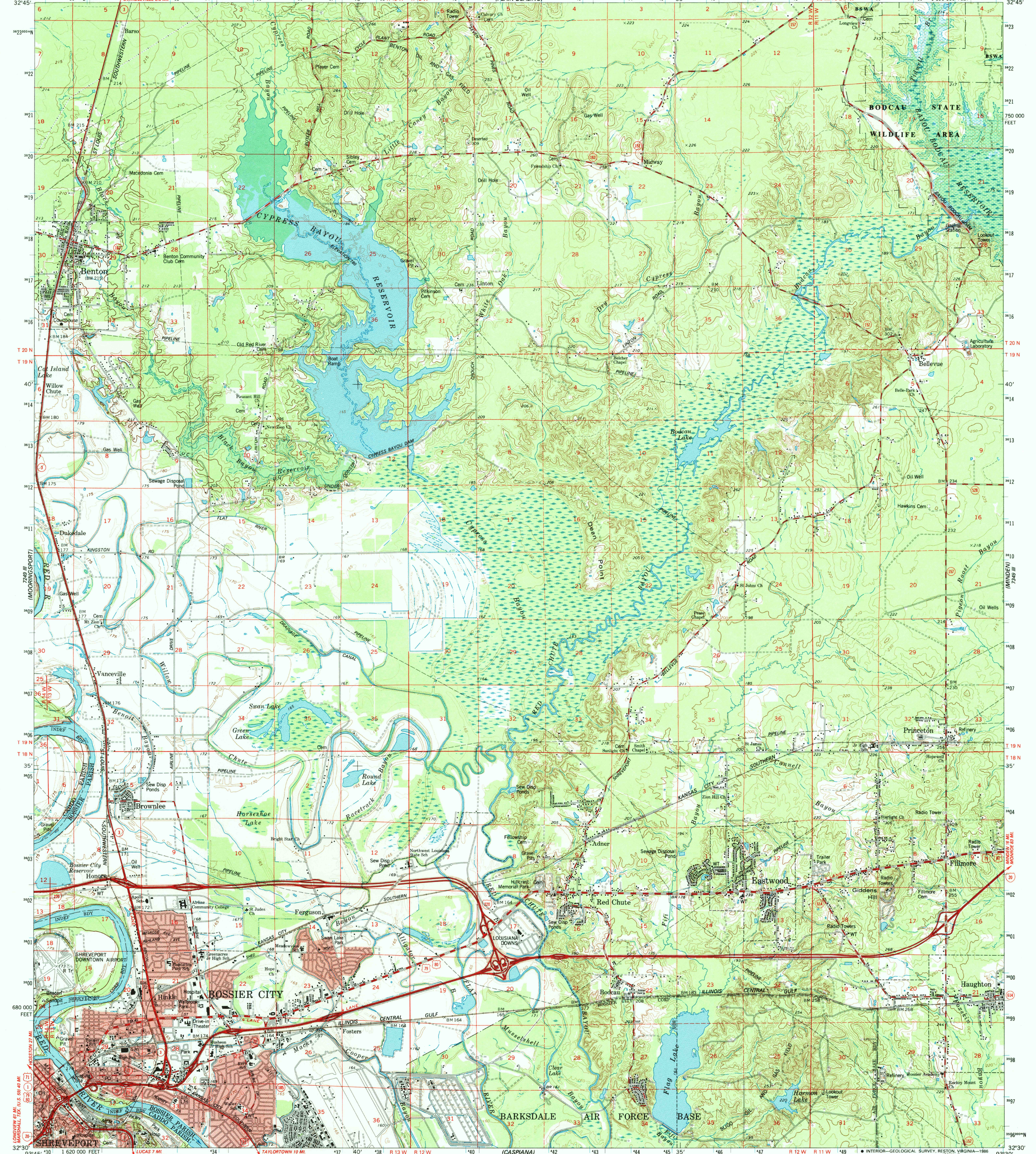

Blue hatching indicates area to be submerged to 185 feet
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to frequent inundation
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 12 meters south and 17 meters east
