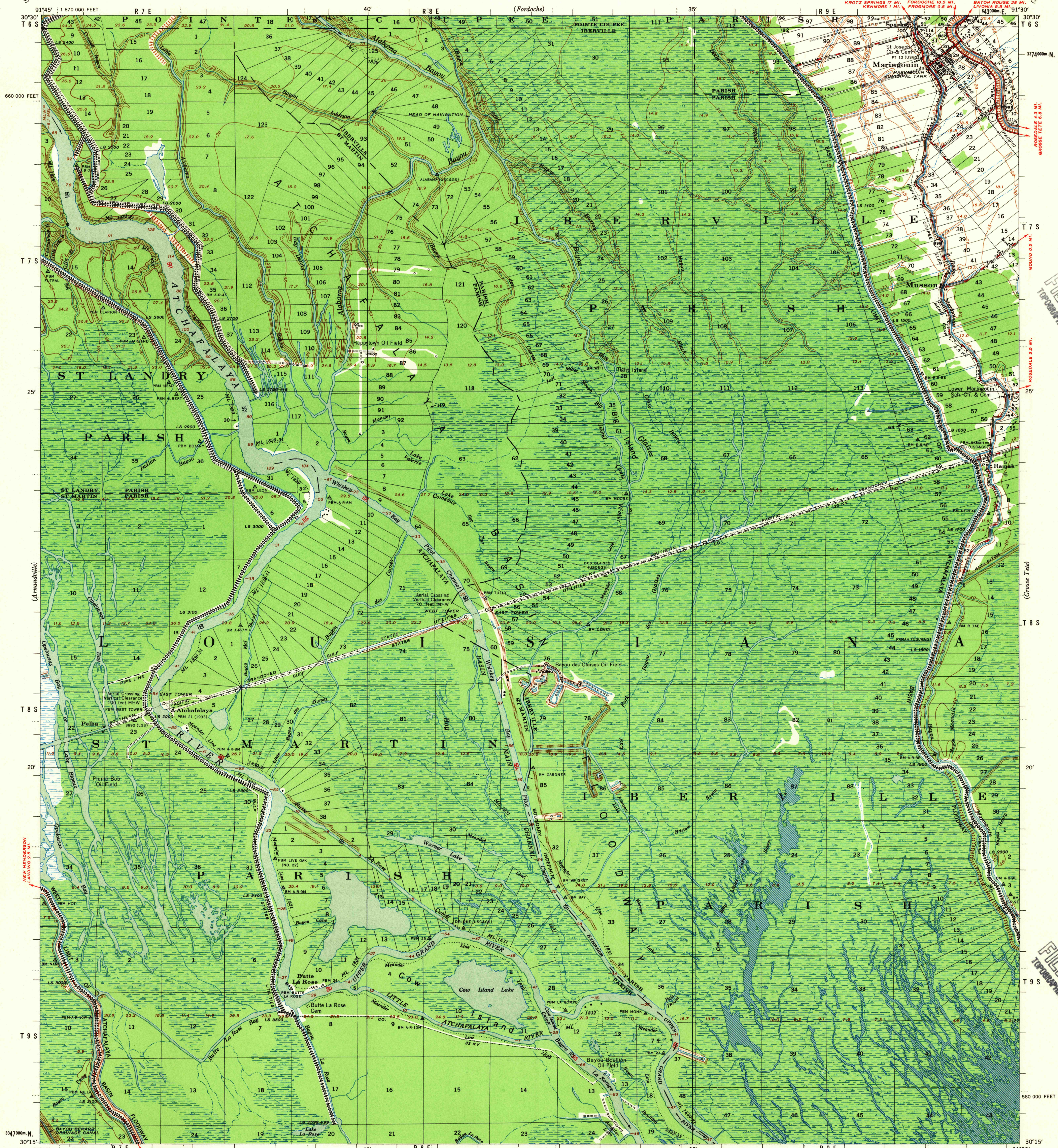
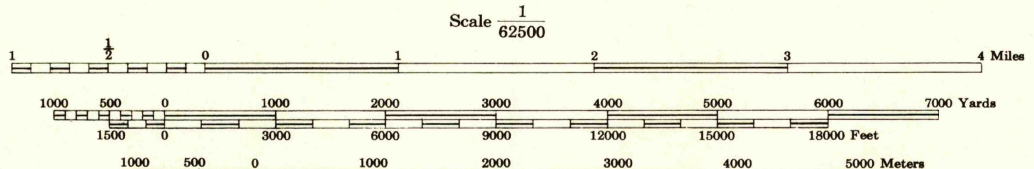




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Descriptions, elevations and geodetic positions of permanent survey marks may be obtained from New Orleans District, Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army, New Orleans, Louisiana.
Topography by New Orleans District, Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army, 1930-31, 1940-41, 1943 and 1950.
Planimetry remapped from aerial photographs by stereo methods.
Aerial photography, September-October 1947, December 1952, October and November 1953. Field checked April 1954.
Depths, in the Atchafalaya River surveyed April-December 1950, expressed in feet below mean low water (M.L.W.).
Mean low water elevation (M.L.W.) on west border expressed in feet, mean sea level.
Elevations in Atchafalaya River, Butte La Rose Cutoff, Upper Grand River, Little Atchafalaya River, Bayou La Poudre, Whiskey Bay Pilot Channel and Whiskey Bay Pilot Channel Extension surveyed April-November 1950, expressed in feet mean sea level.
Political boundaries are shown according to best available information.
Work under Flood Control Act shown as of April 1954.
