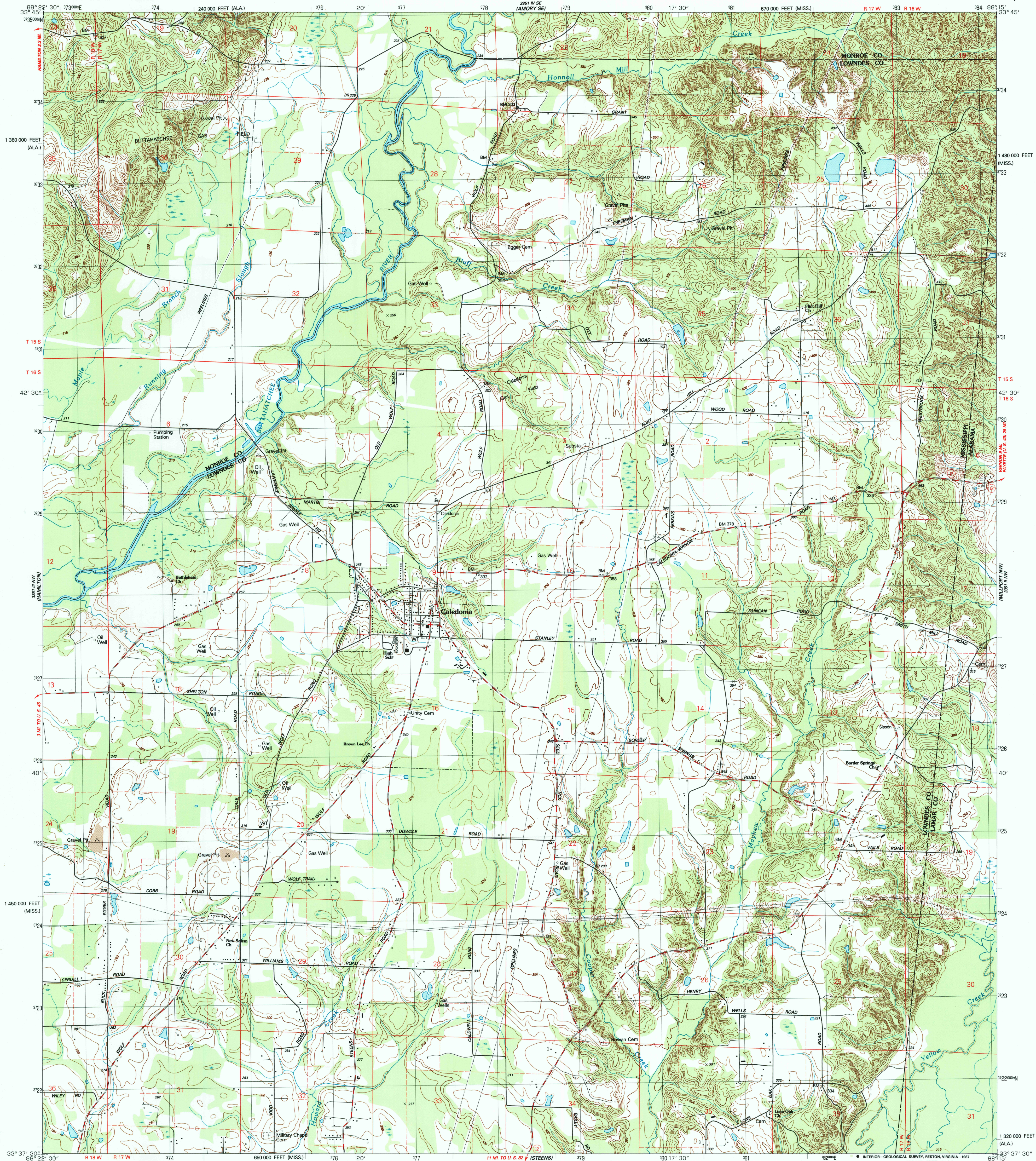

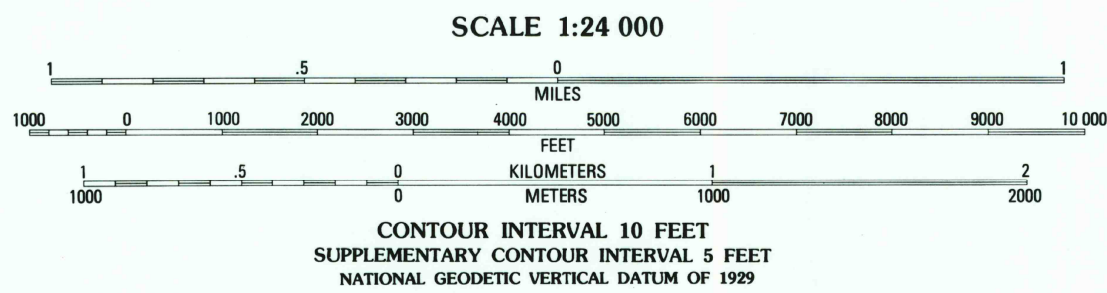
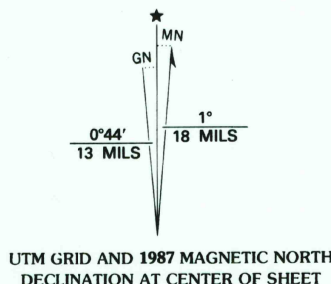
Projection: Mississippi coordinate system, east zone (transverse Mercator)

10,000-foot grid ticks: Mississippi coordinate system, east zone and Alabama coordinate system, west zone

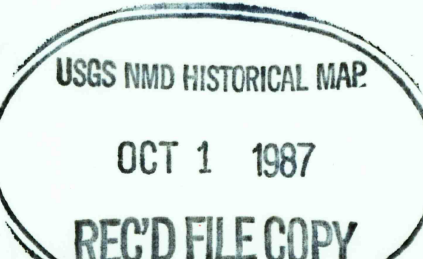
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 16 1927 North American Datum
