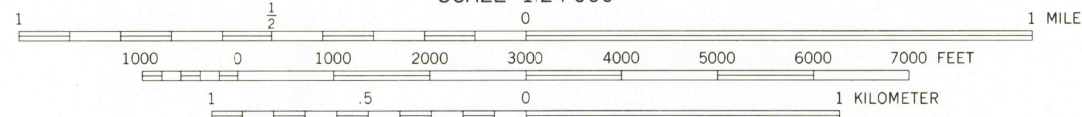
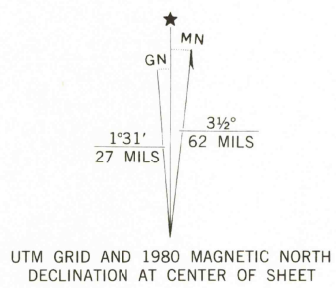

Projection: Mississippi coordinate system, east zone (transverse Mercator). 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Mississippi coordinate system, east and west zones. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 16 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 9 meters south and 7 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.

Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation.
