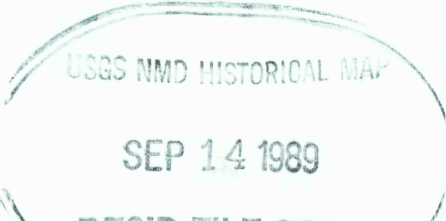
FOUR CORNERS QUADRANGLE
