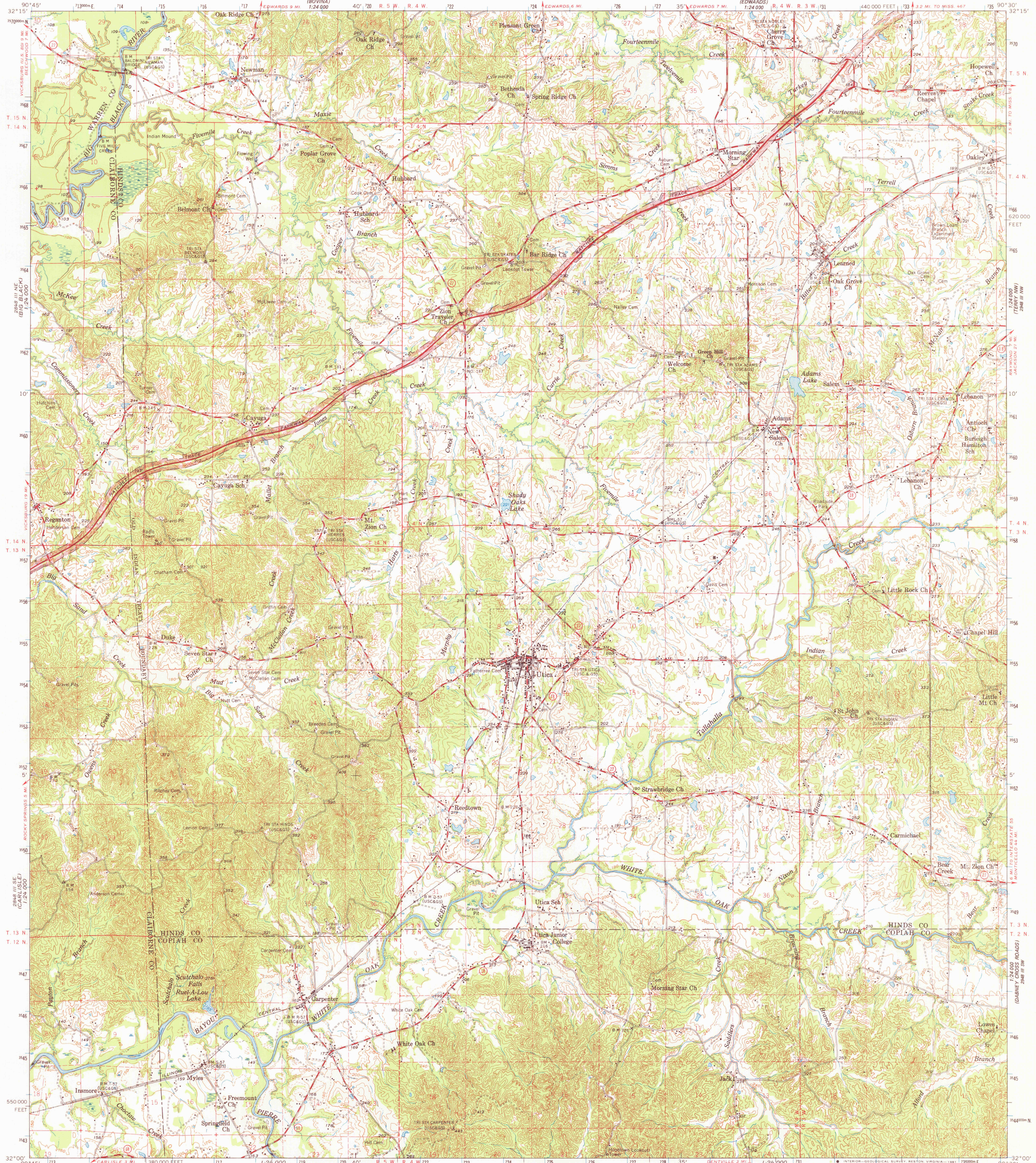
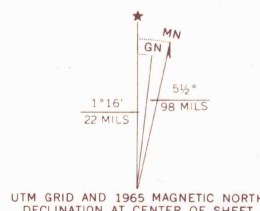

are shown at 5 mile intervals
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
move the projection lines 14 meters south and
9 meters east
