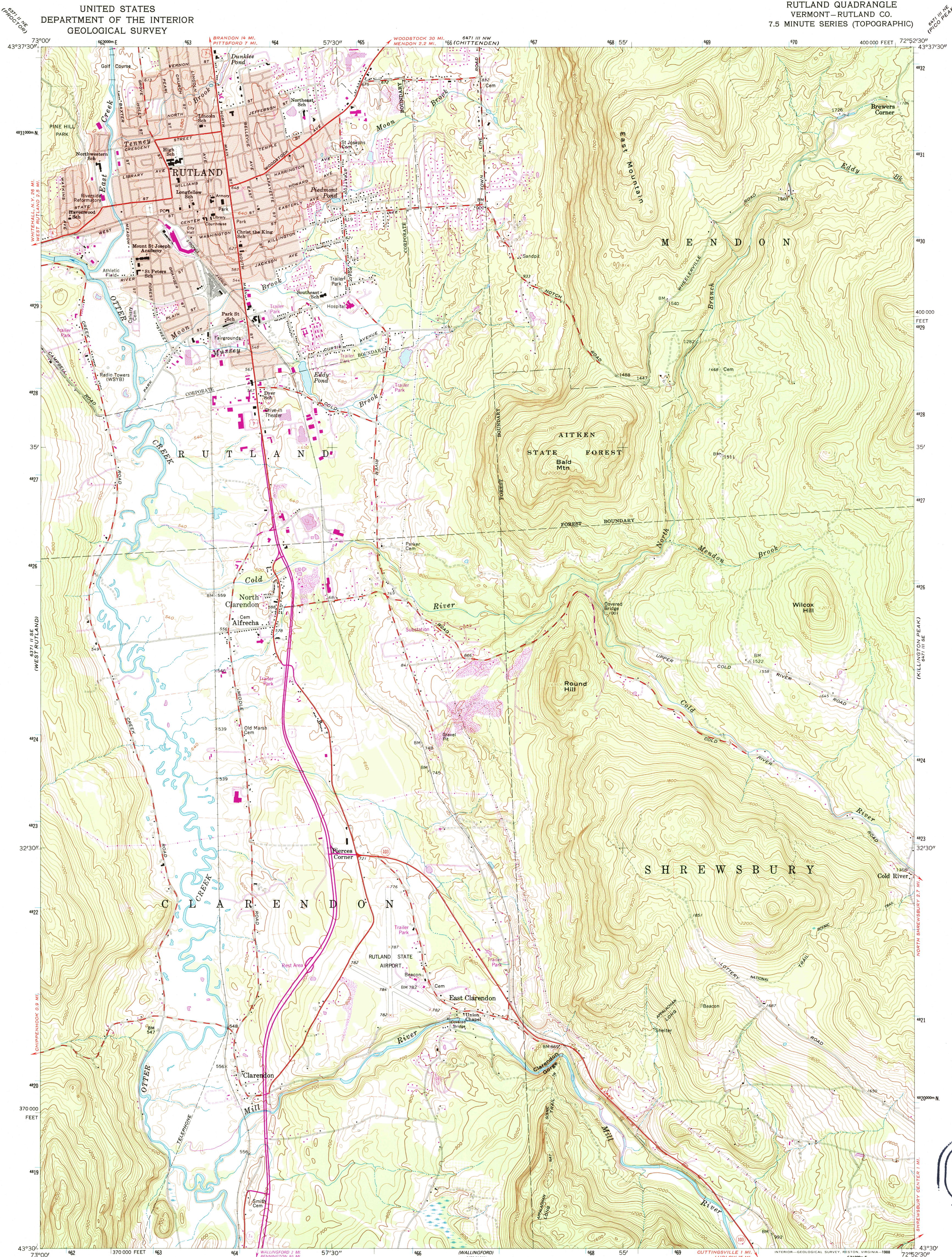

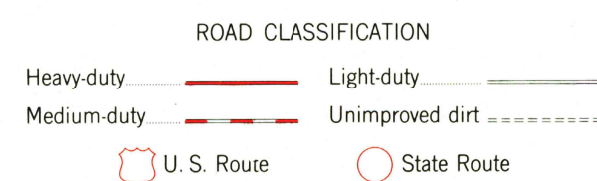
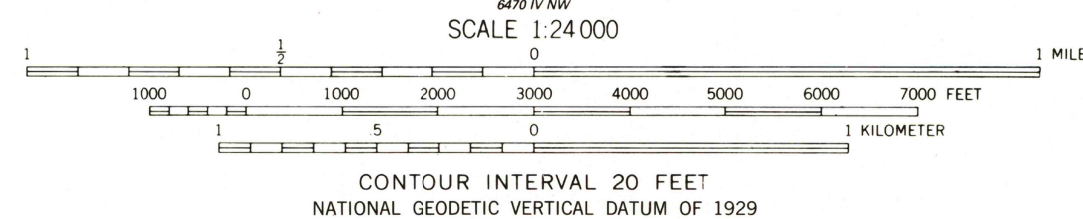
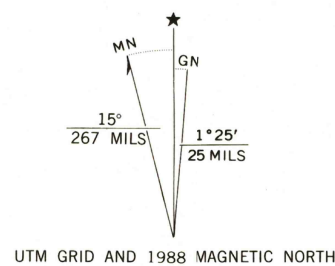
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1957. Field checked 1961

Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Vermont coordinate system, 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 18, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters south and 36 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
