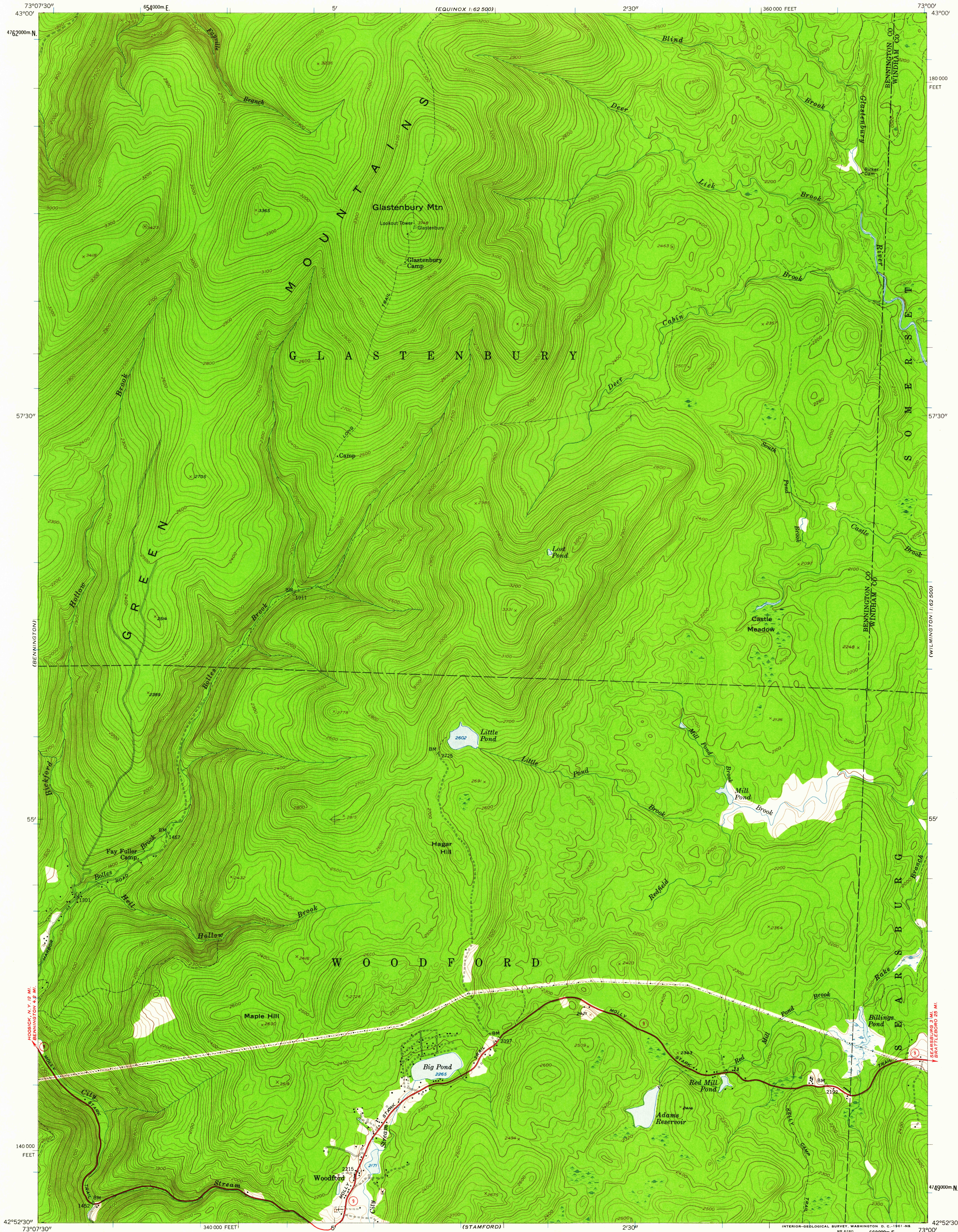

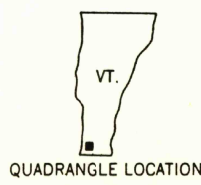
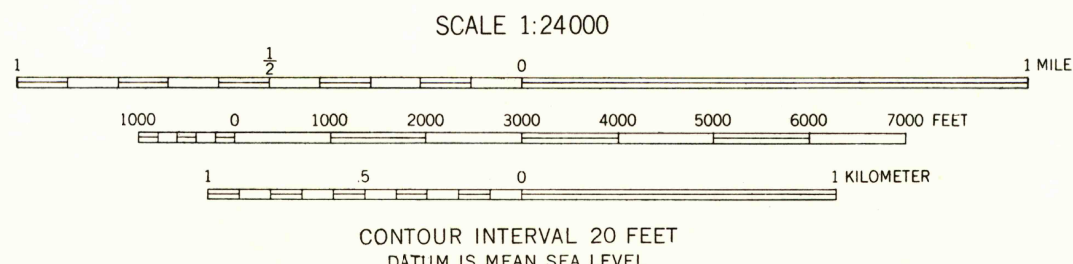
WOODFORD QUADRANGLE
