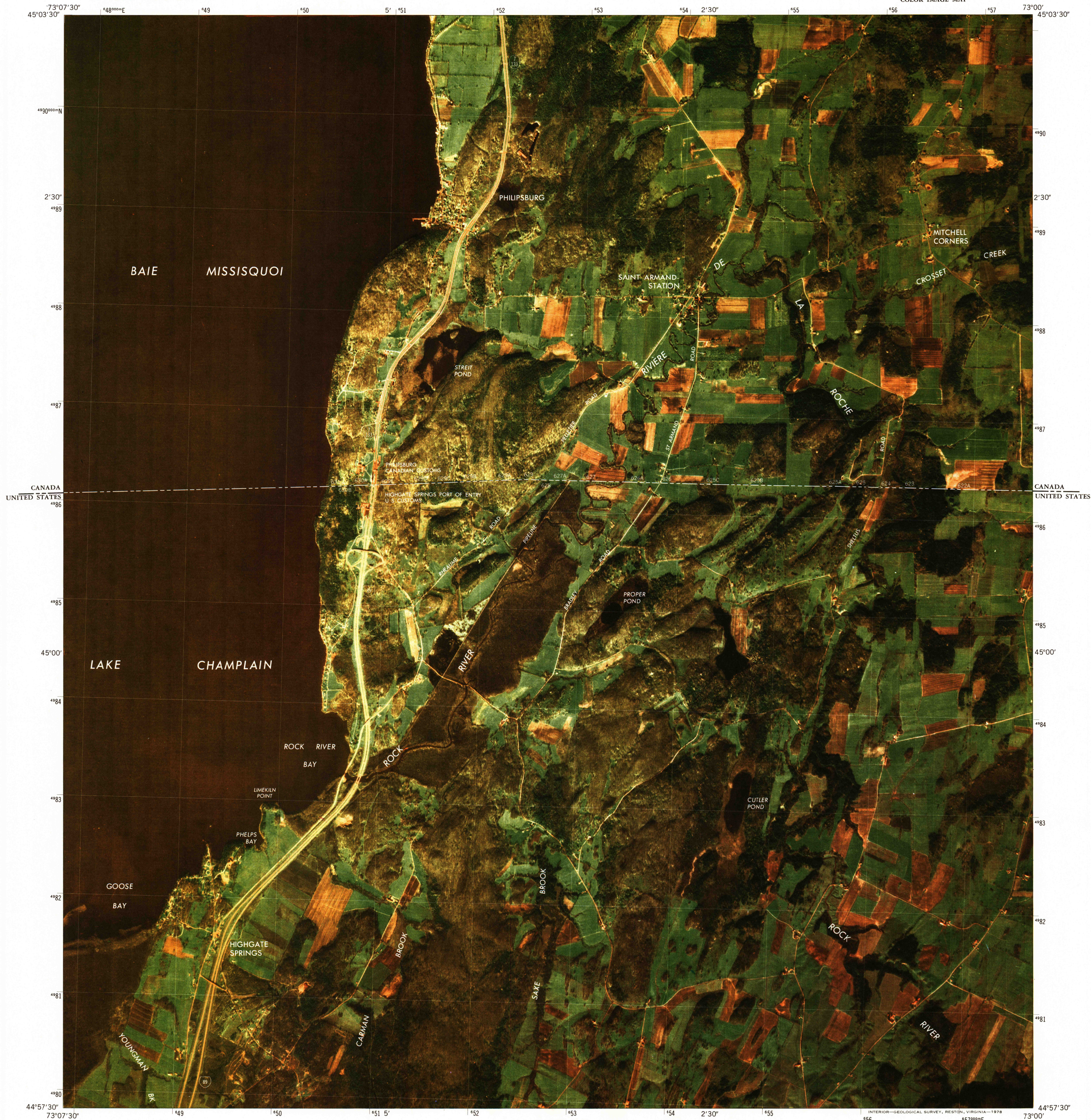

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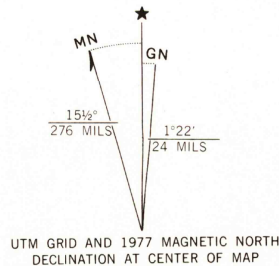
HIGHGATE SPRINGS PORT OF ENTRY

COLOR IMAGE MAP



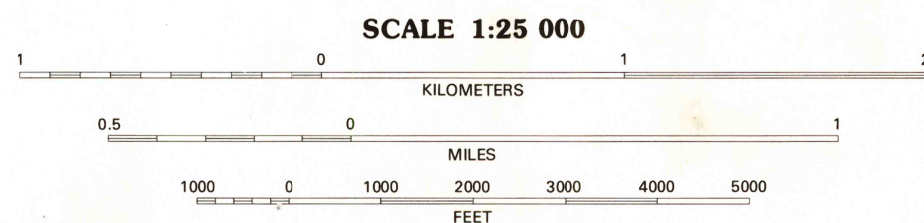
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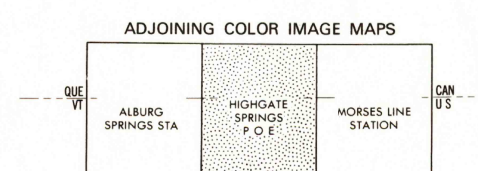
Projection and 1000-meter grid: Universal Transverse
