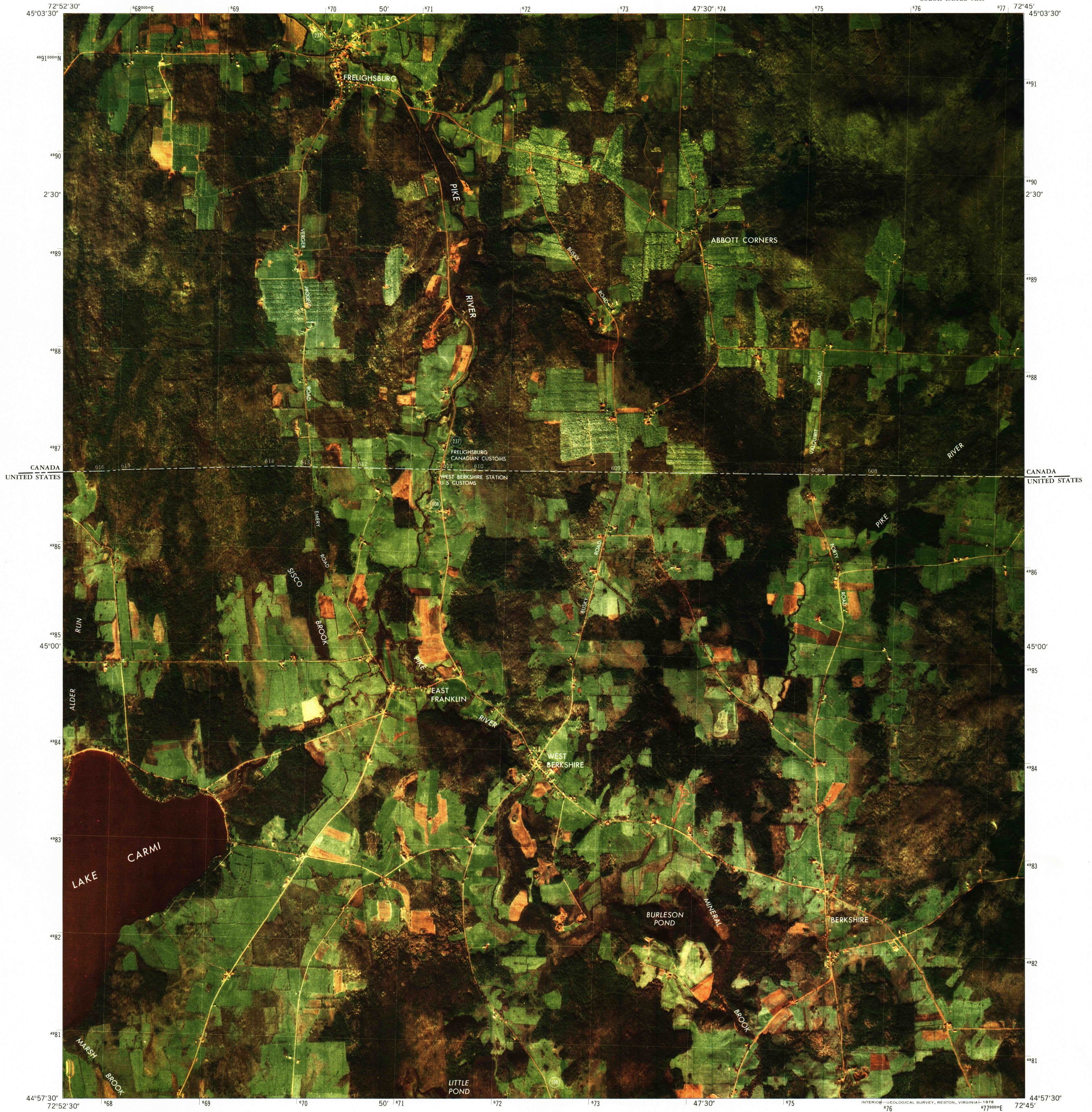

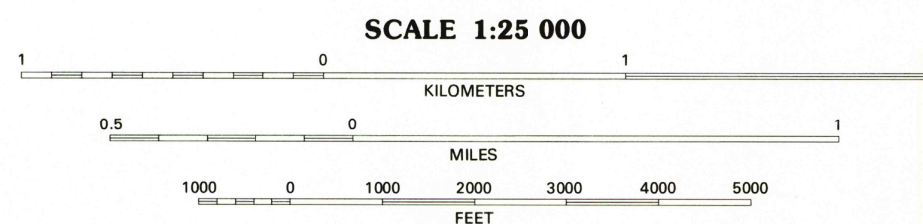
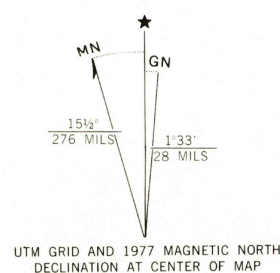

COLOR IMAGE MAP

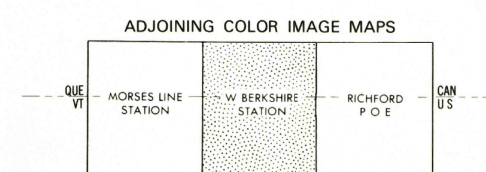
