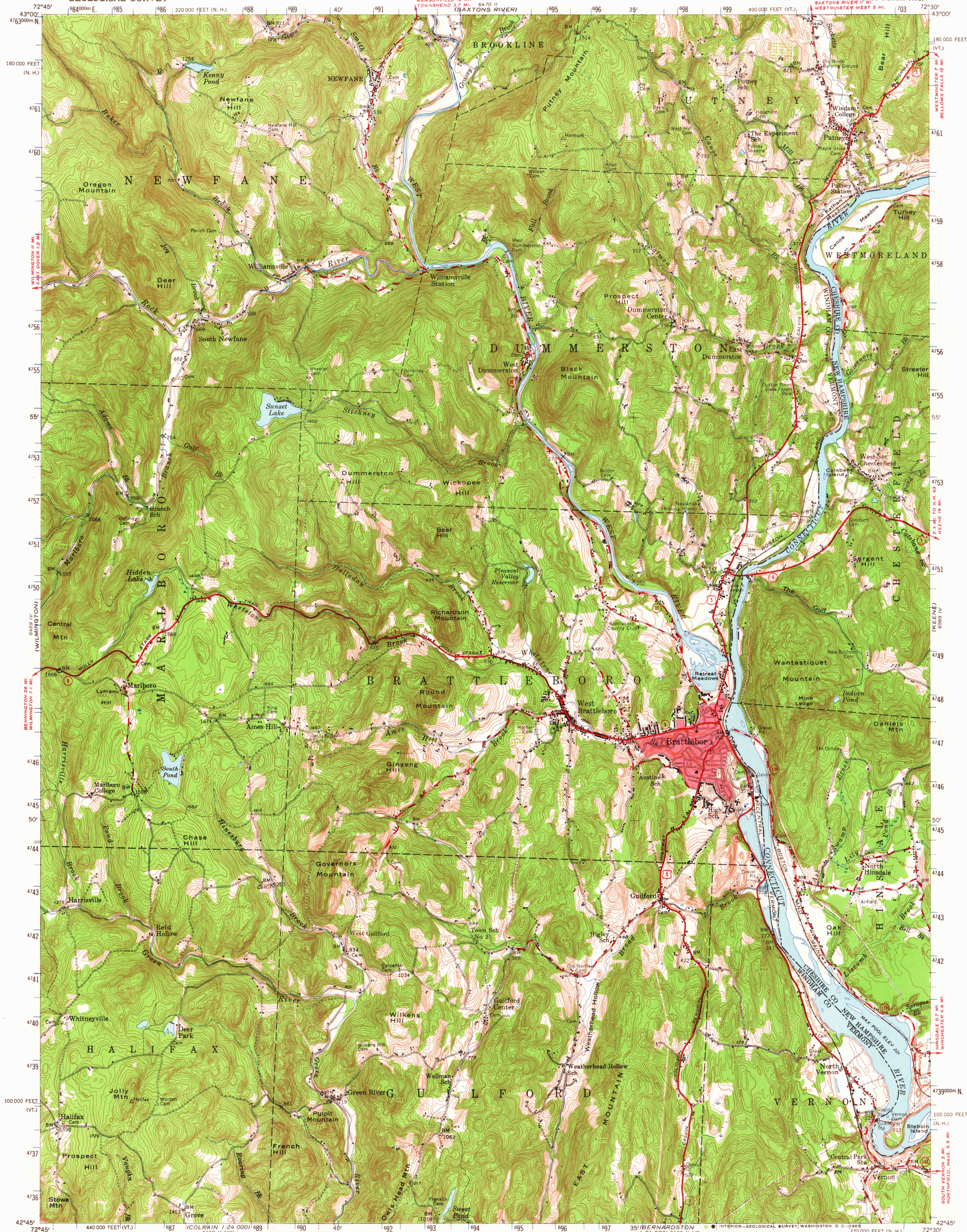

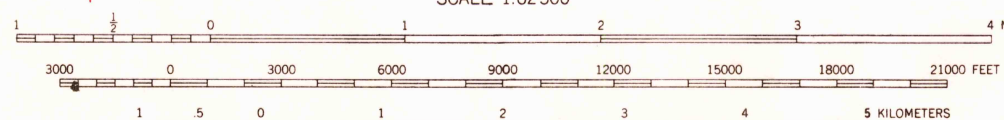
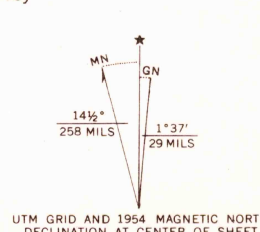
Red tint indicates area in which only

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown

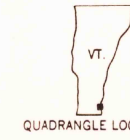
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
