

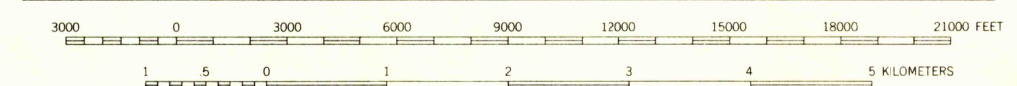

DECLINATION, 1954

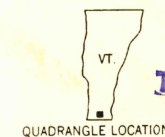
MONROE BRIDGE, MASS. 2.3 MI.
