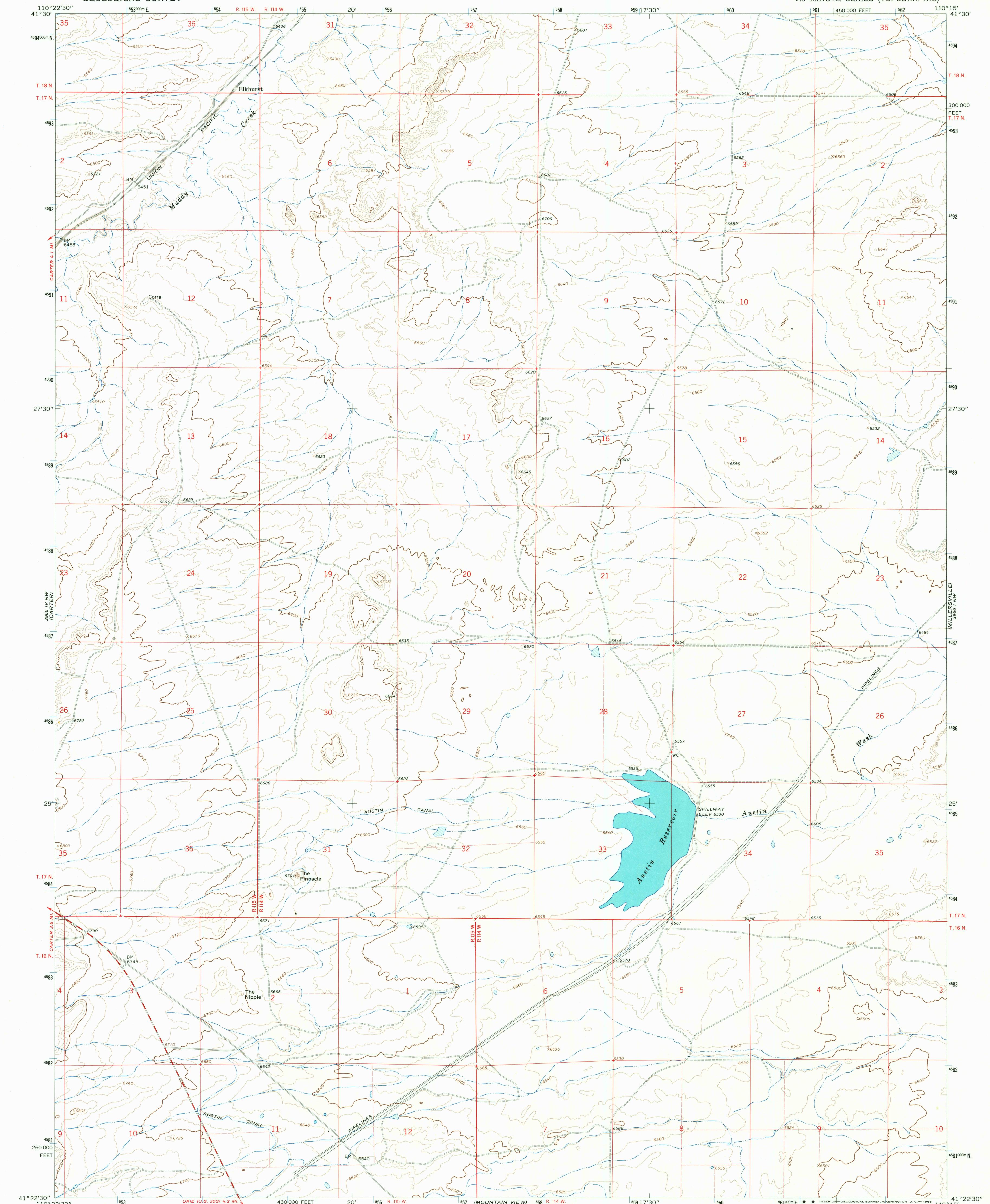

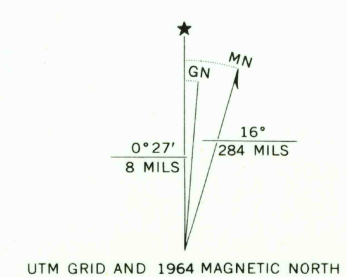
10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system,

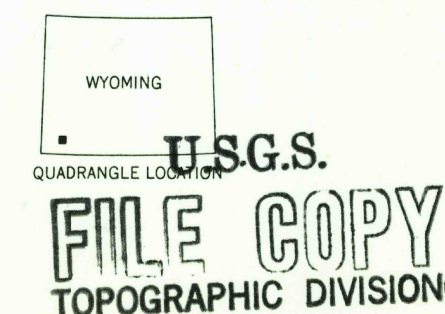
