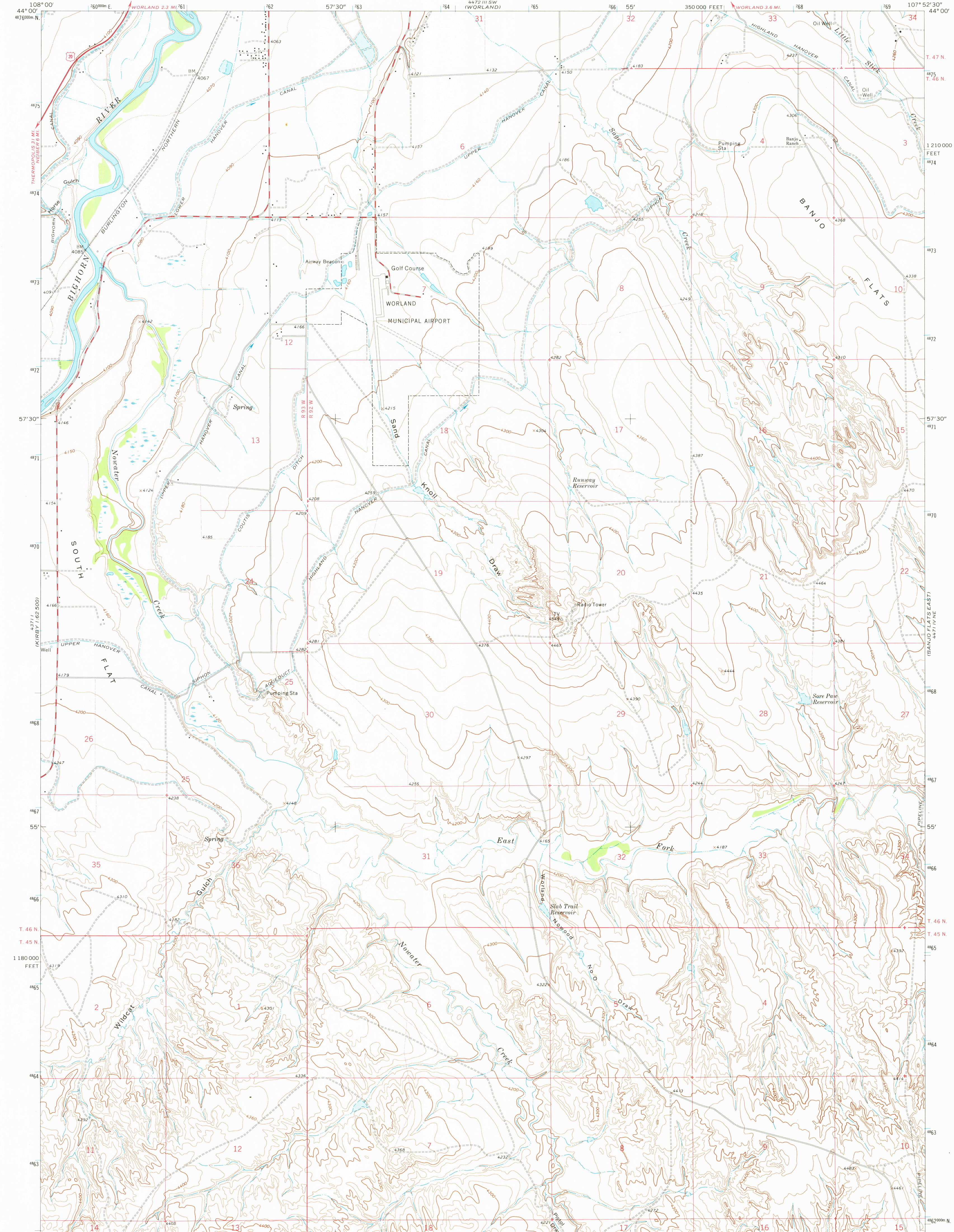

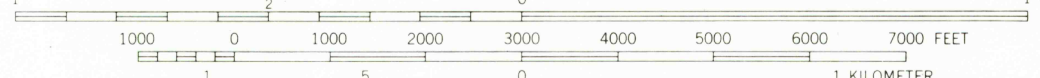
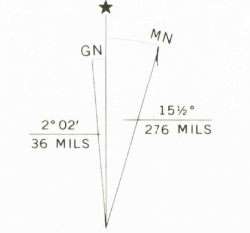
Polyconic projection, 1927 North American datum

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

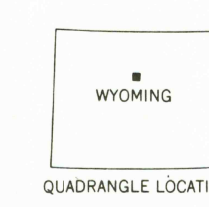
Land lines are omitted in areas of extensive tract surveys
