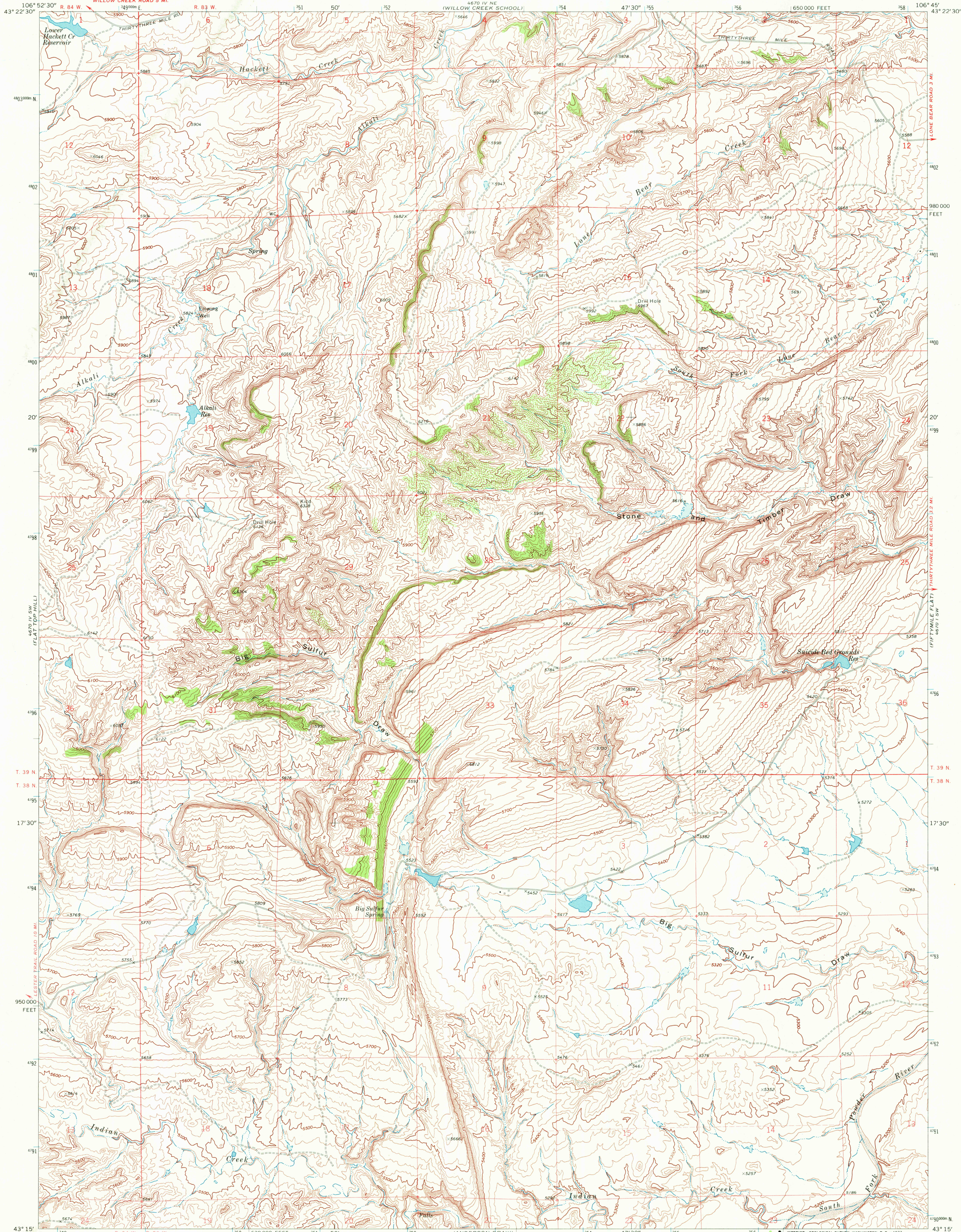

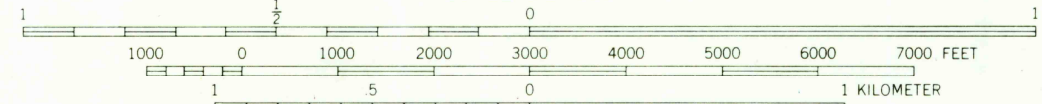
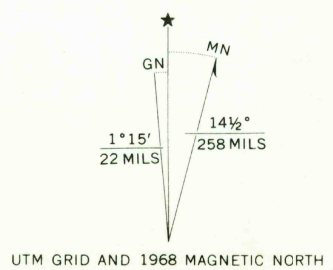

10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, east central zone

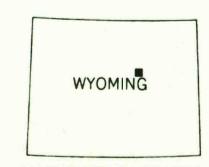
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue
