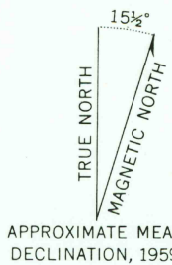

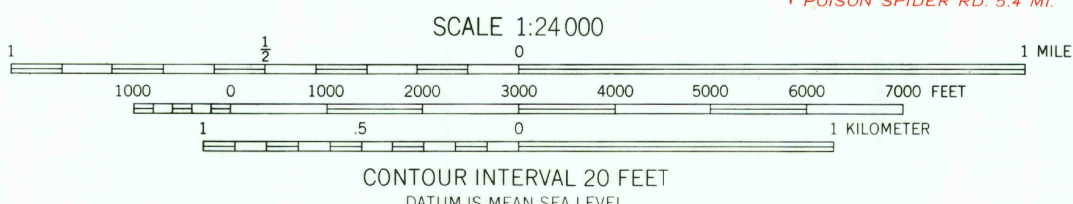

zone 13, shown in blue

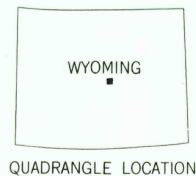


APPROXIMATE MEAN
