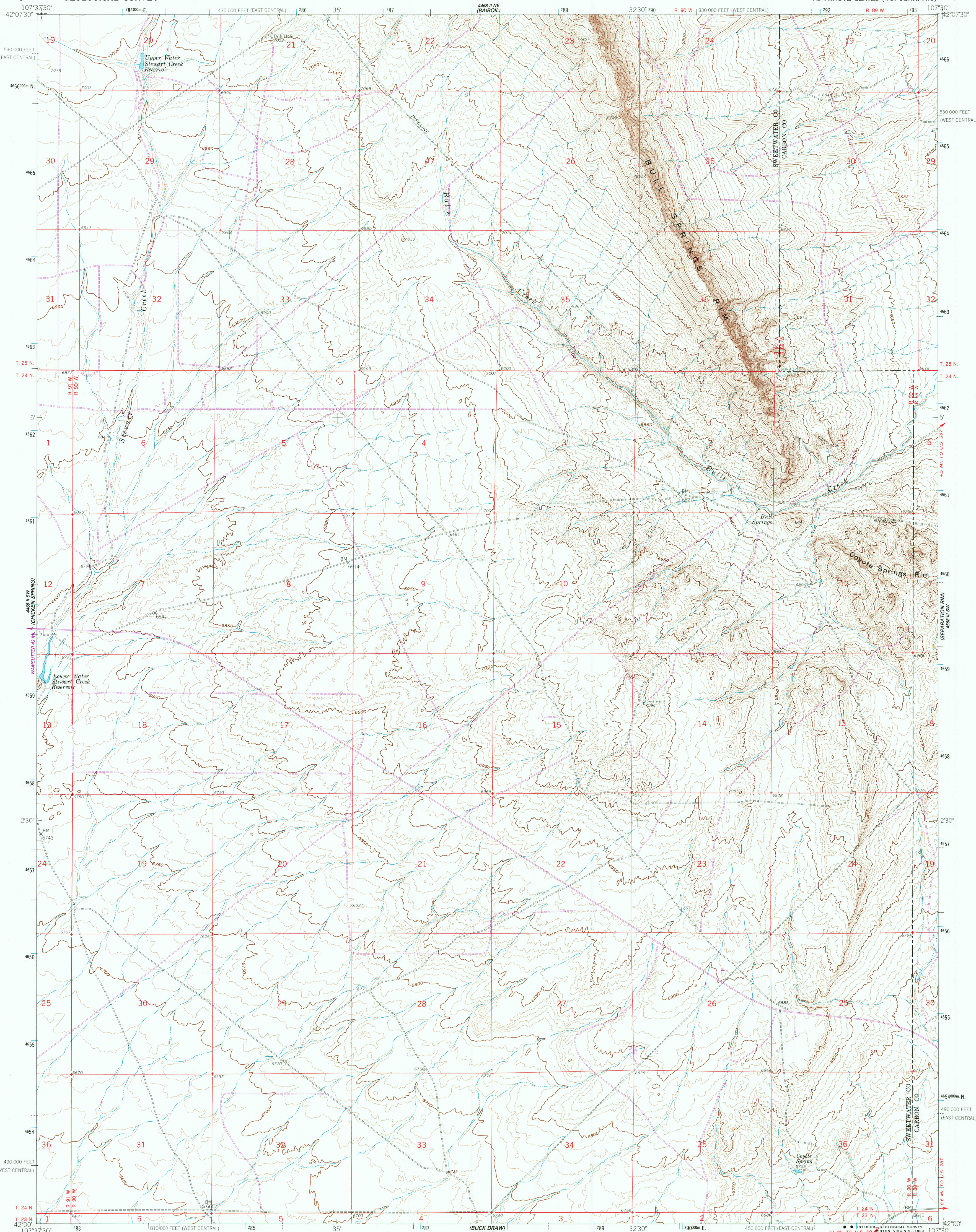

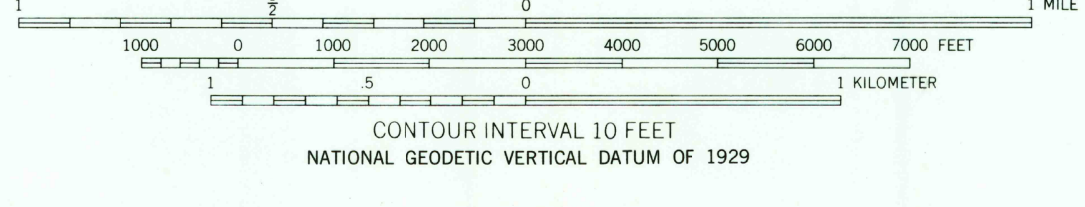
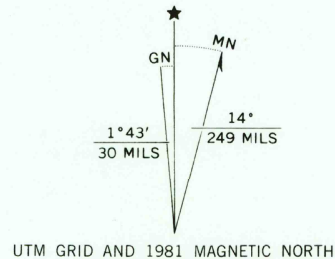
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1957. Field checked 1960

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, west central and east central zones

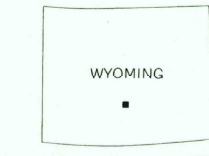
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue
