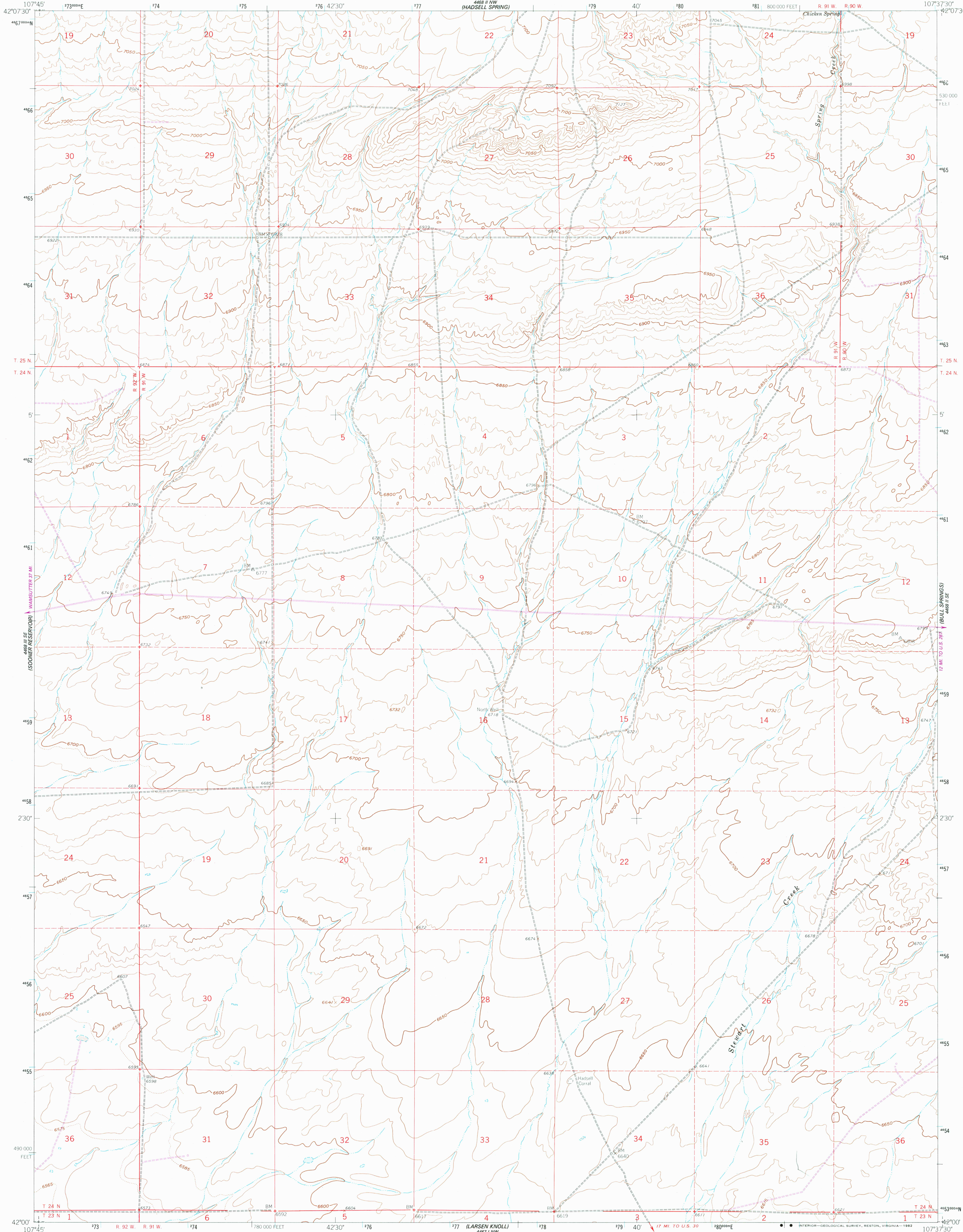

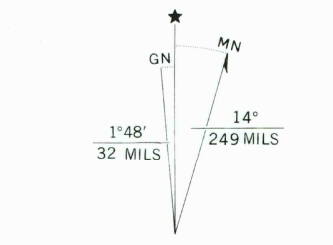

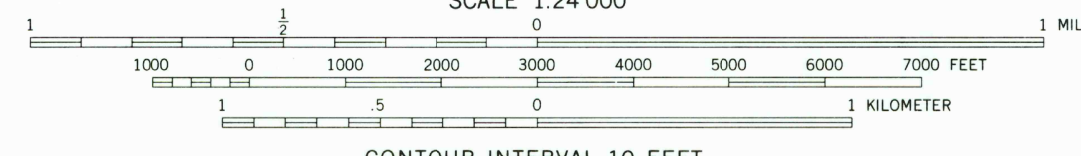
Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum

53 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

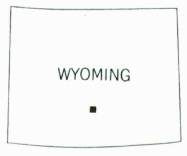


UTM GRID AND 1981 MAGNETIC NORTH
