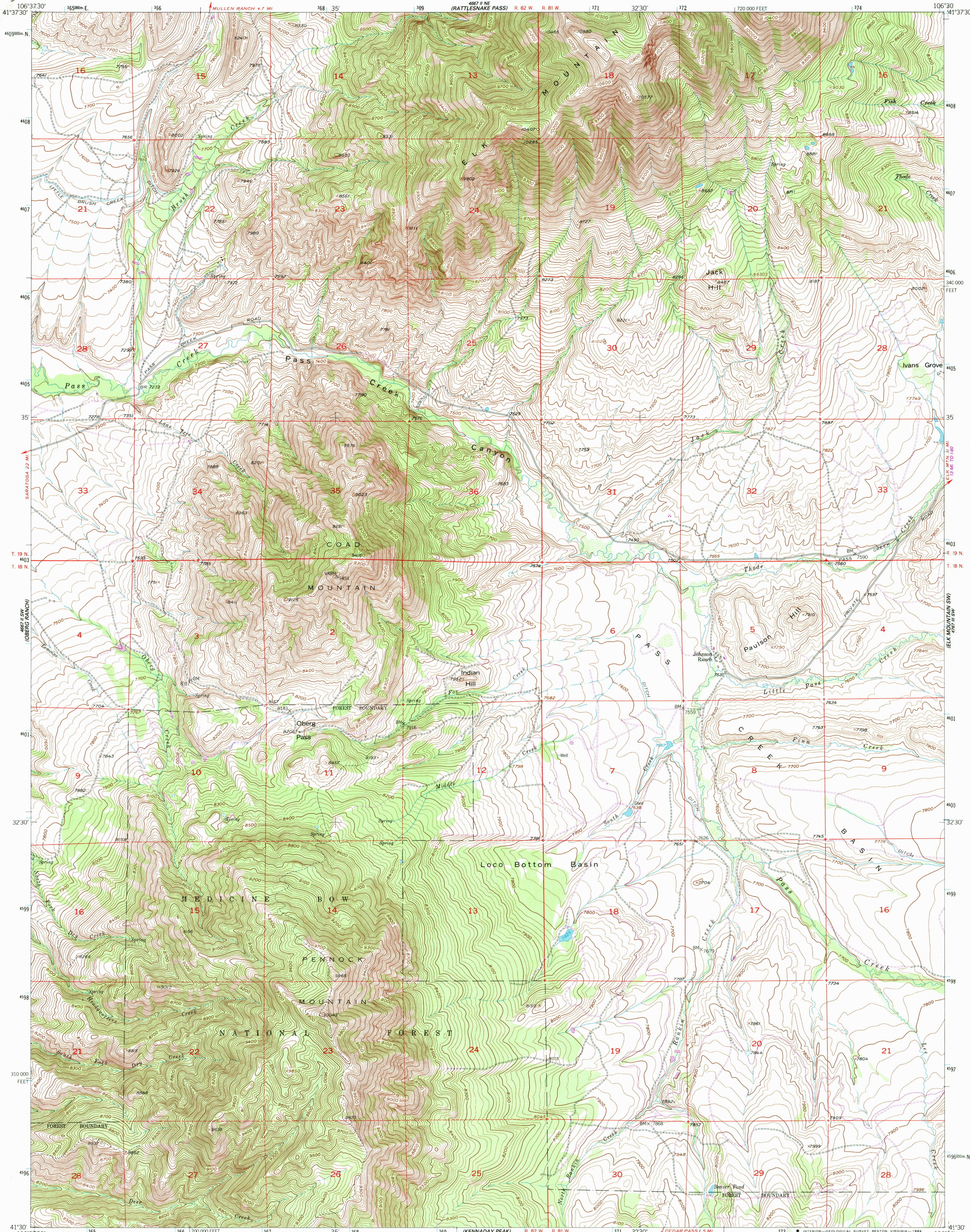

Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American Datum 10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, east central zone

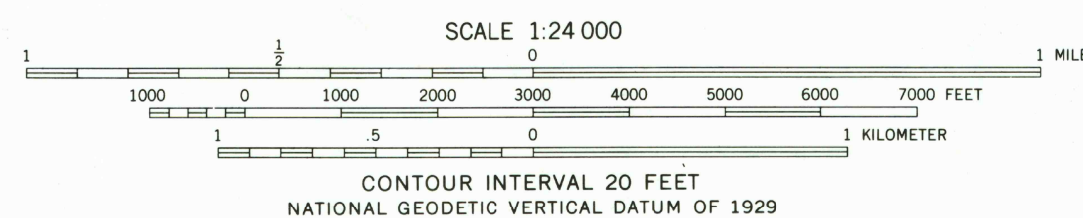
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue

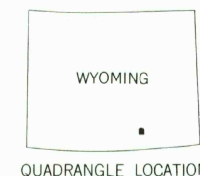
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
