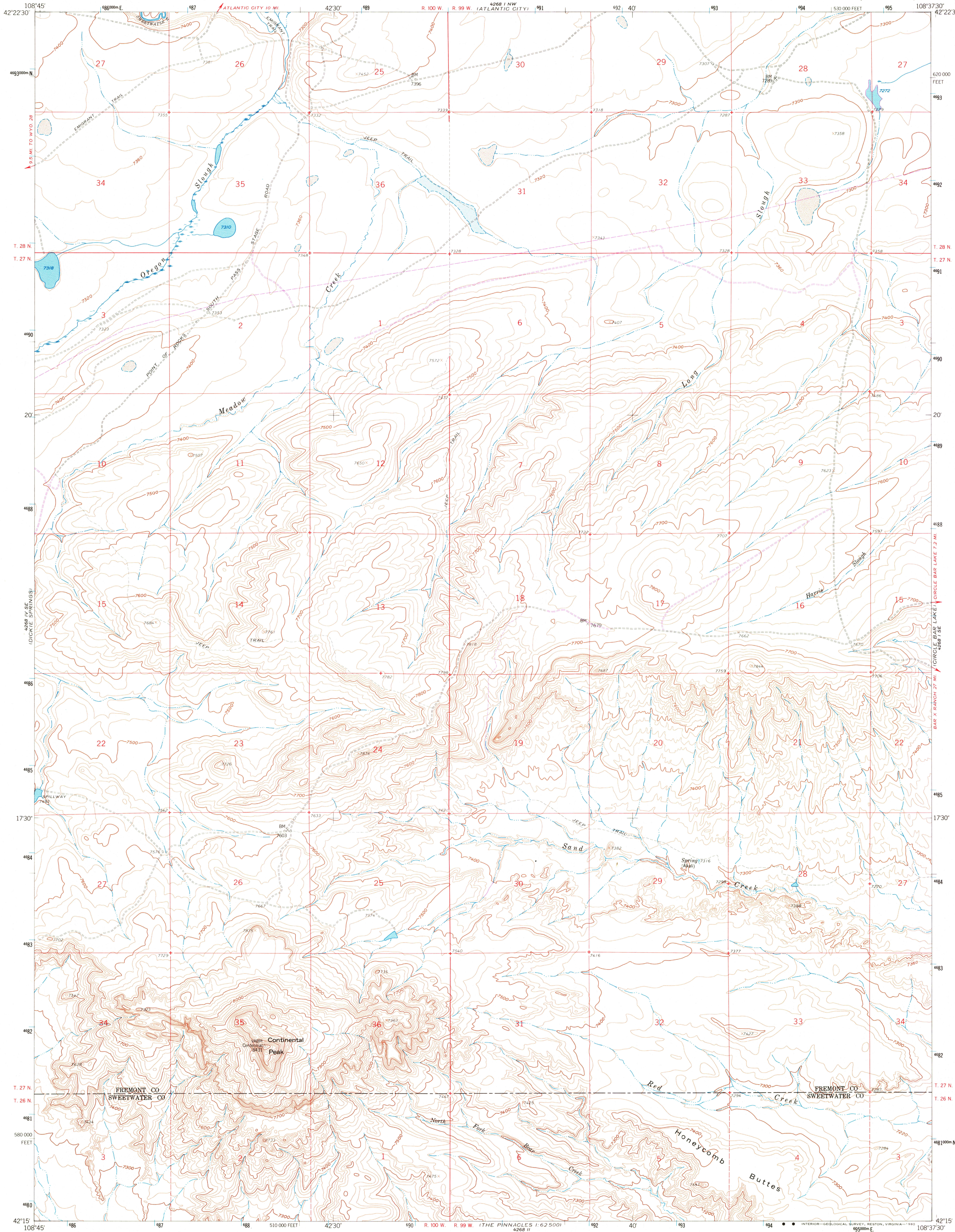

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

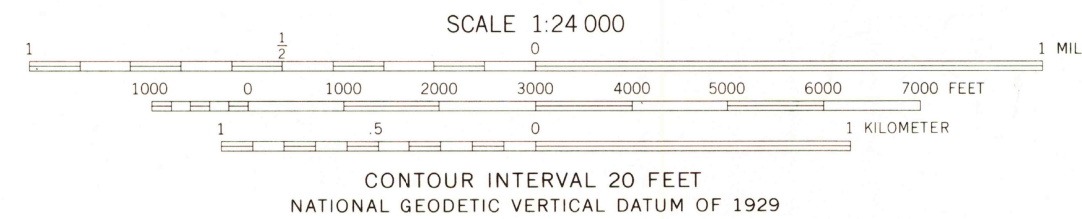
10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, west central zone
