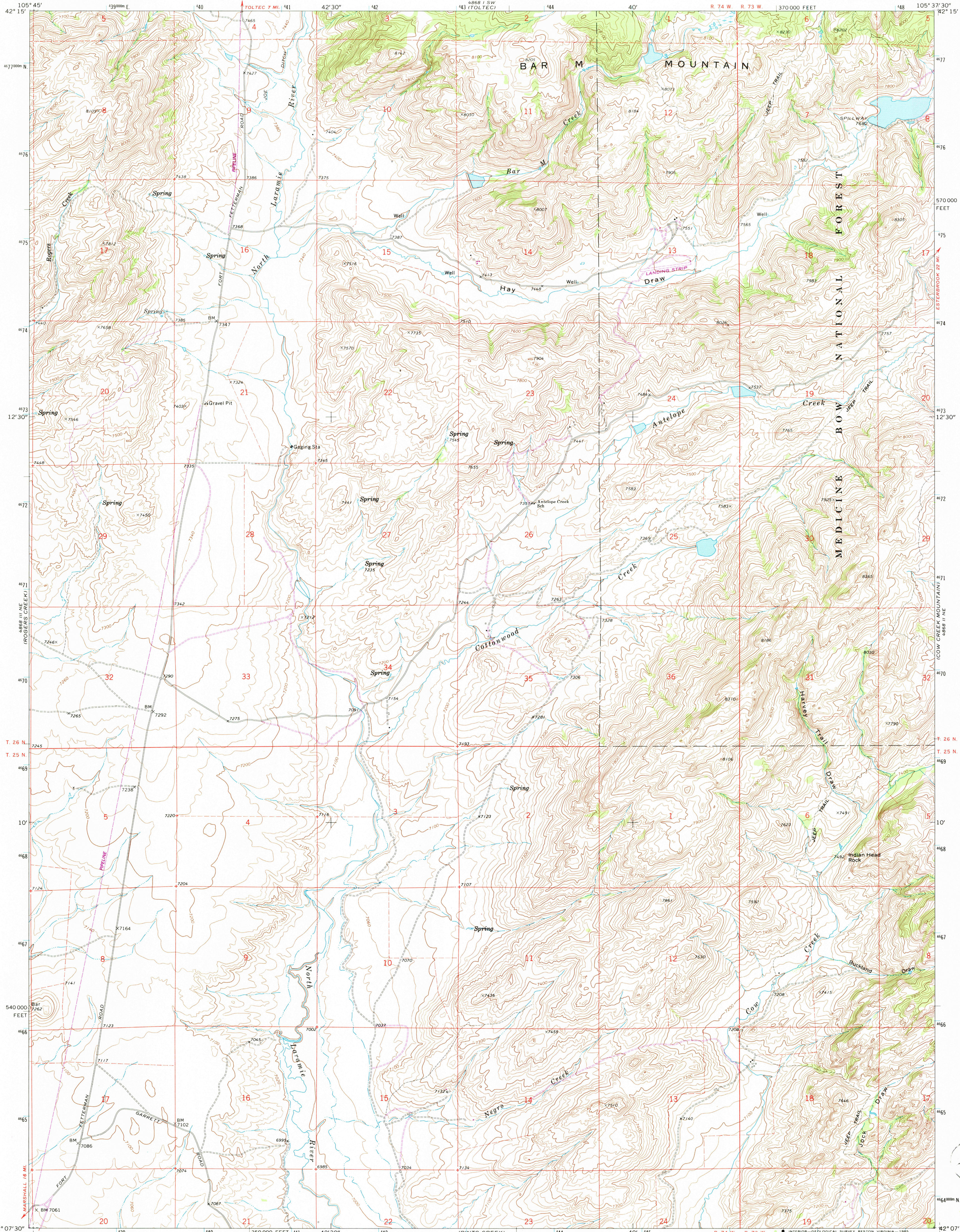

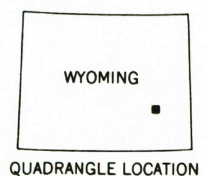
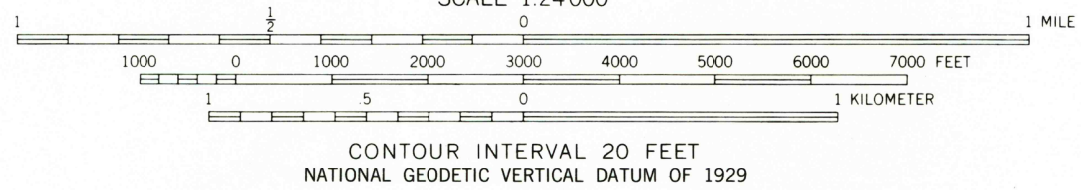

move the projection lines 7 meters north and  
48 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries  
of the National or State reservations shown on this map
