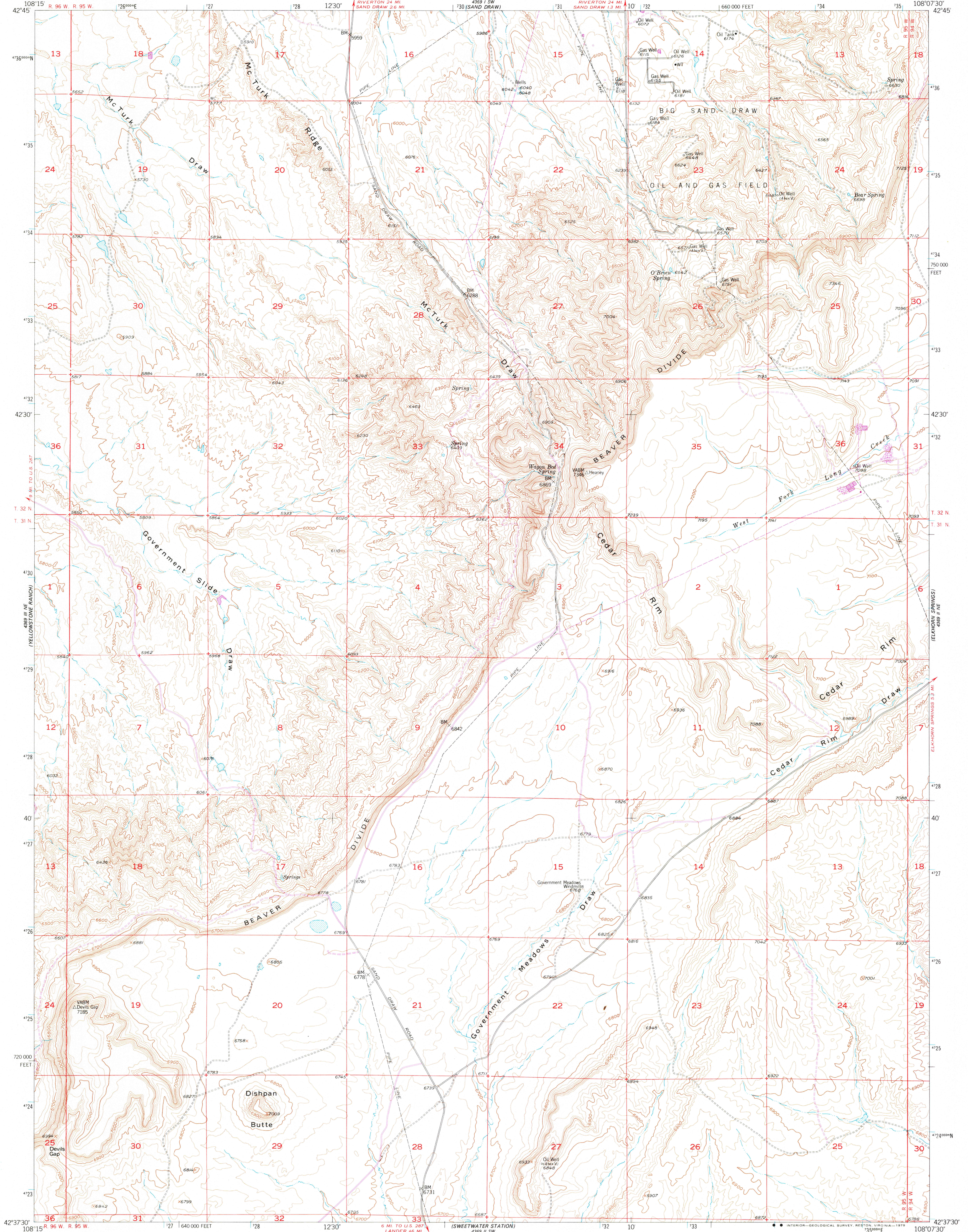

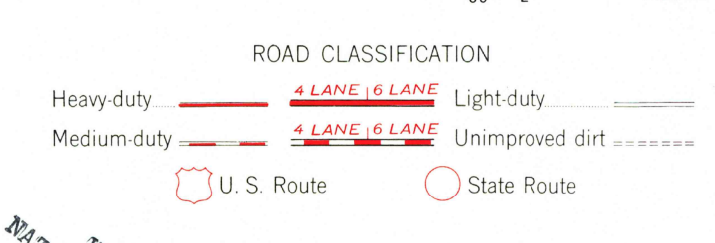
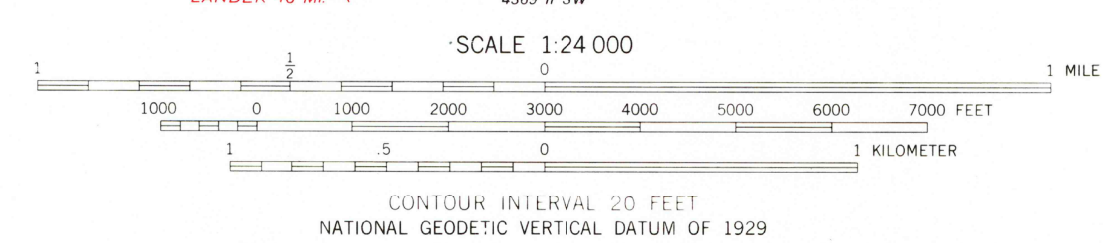
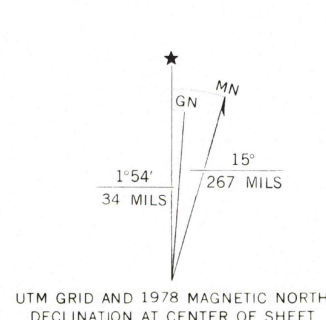
Aerial photographs taken 1949. Field check 1953
