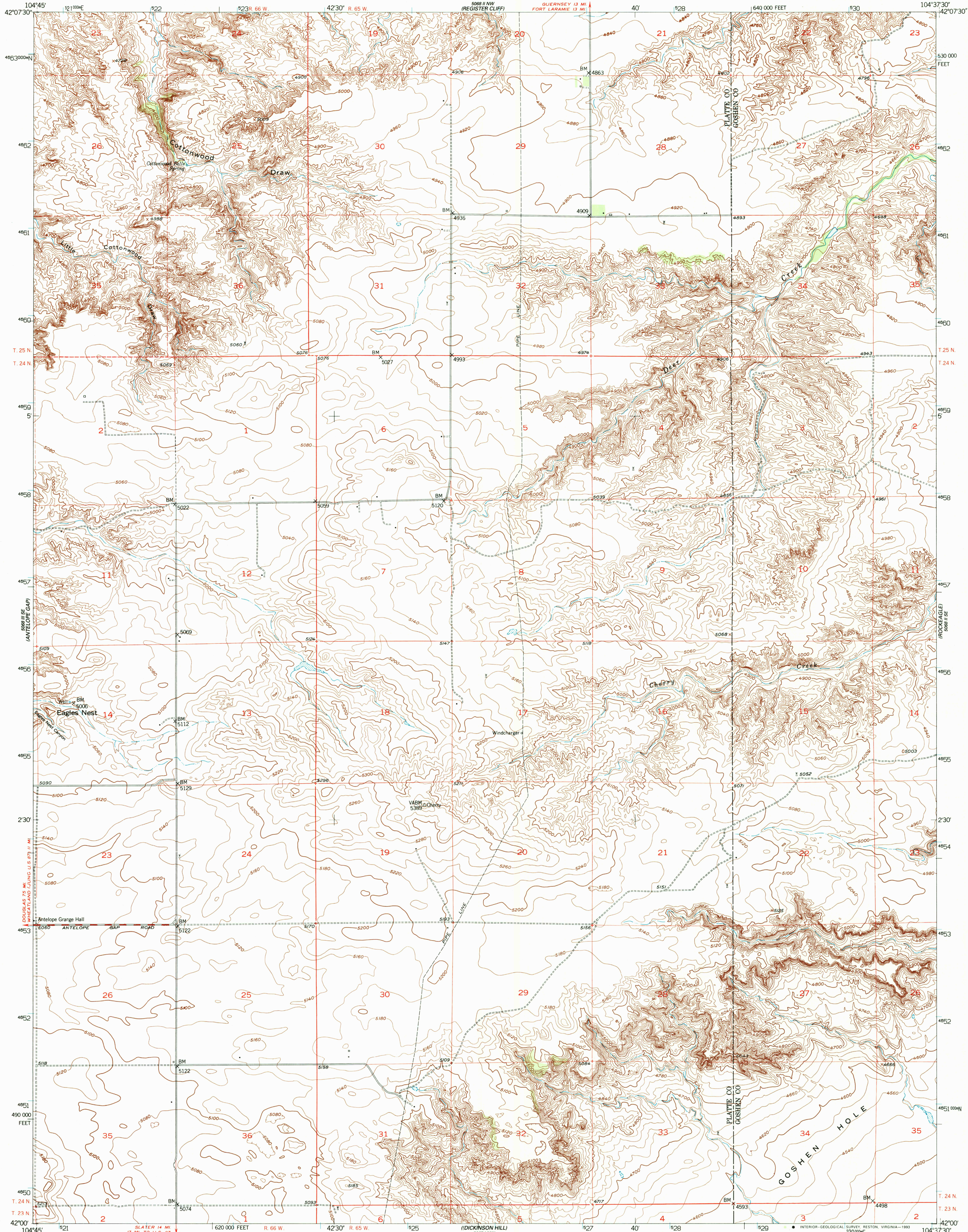
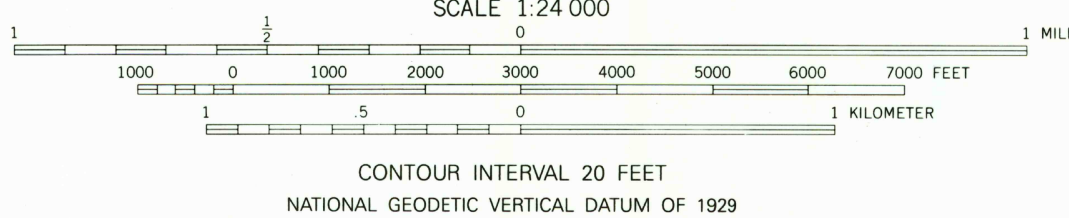
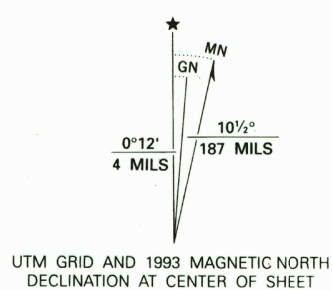

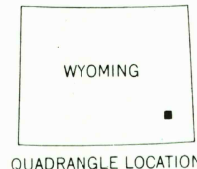
EAGLES NEST QUADRANGLE

The difference between NAD 27 and North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) for 7.5 minute intersections is given in USGS Bulletin 1875. The NAD 83 is shown by dashed corner ticks. Photosinspected from 1991 source; no major culture or drainage changes observed. Boundaries and names verified 1993.
