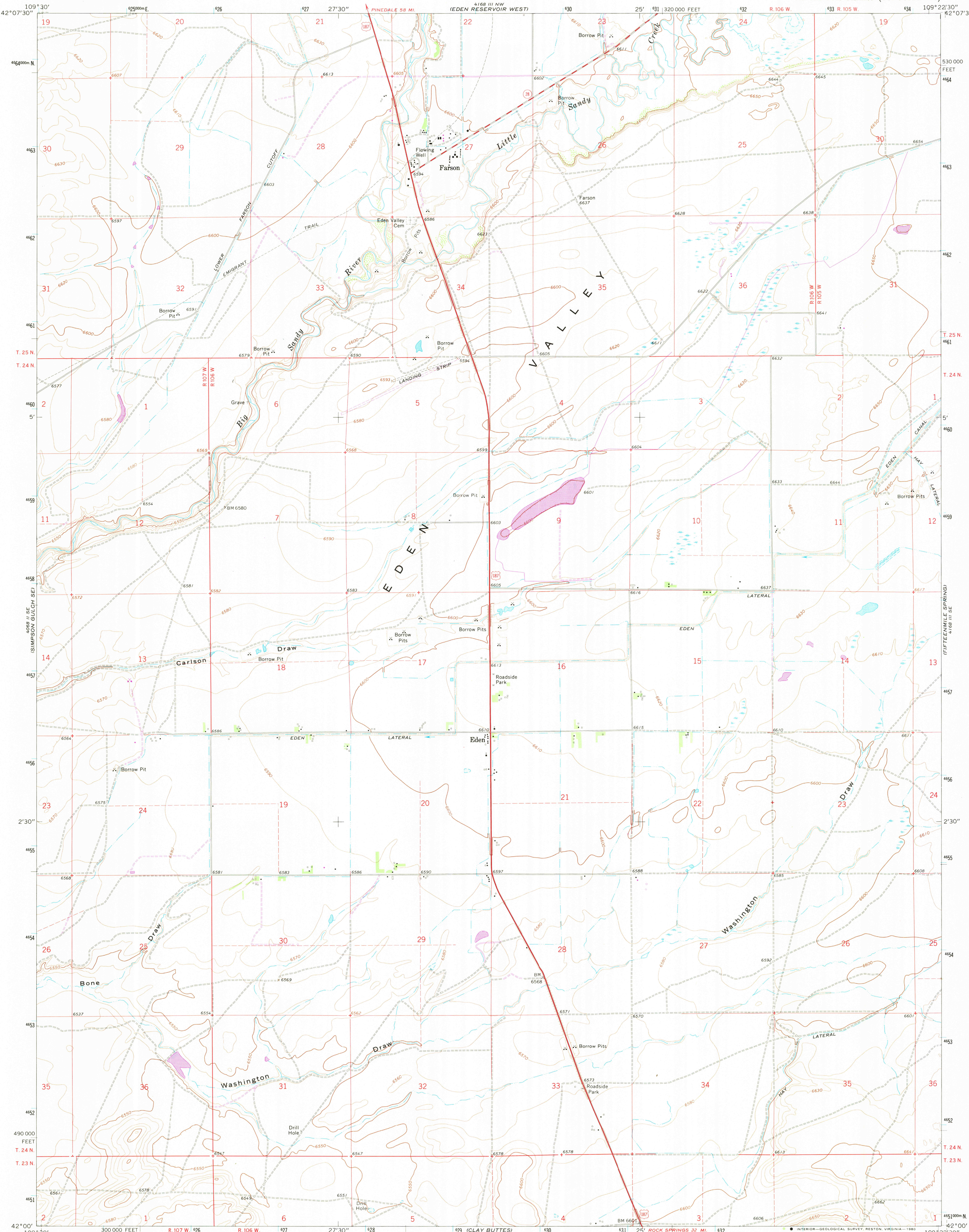

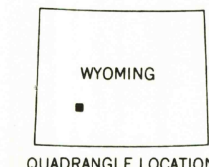
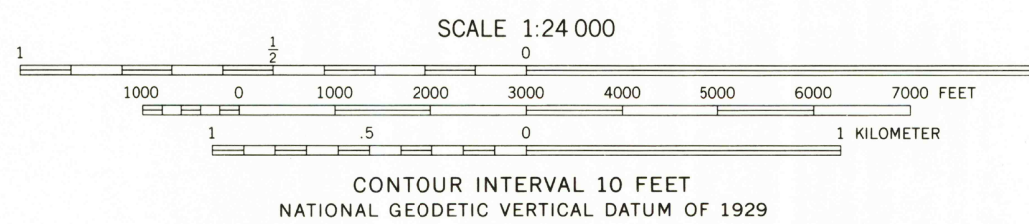
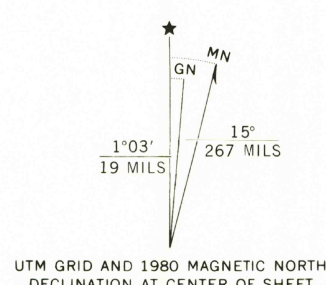
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1967. Field checked 1968

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 9 meters north and 58 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
