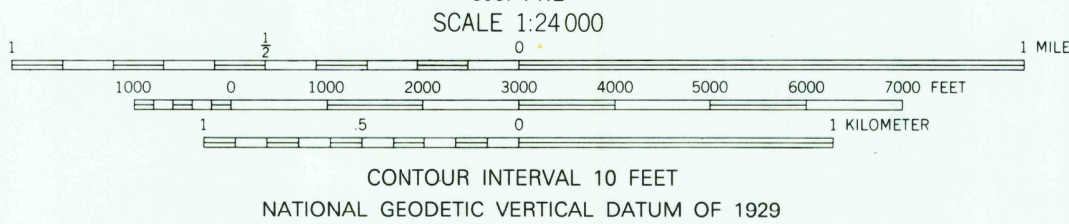

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, west and west central zones

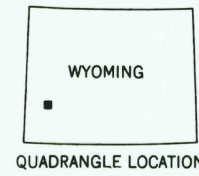
