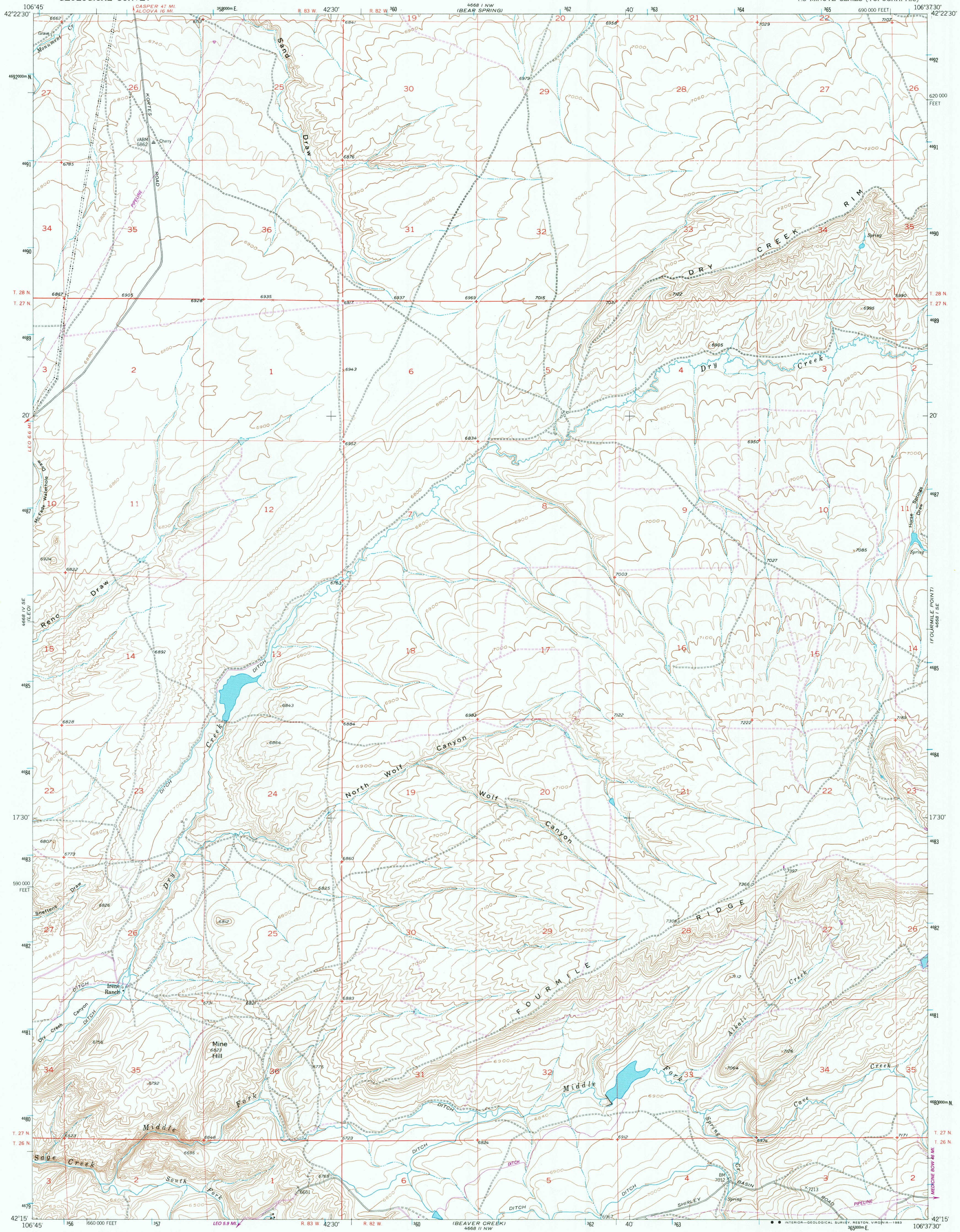


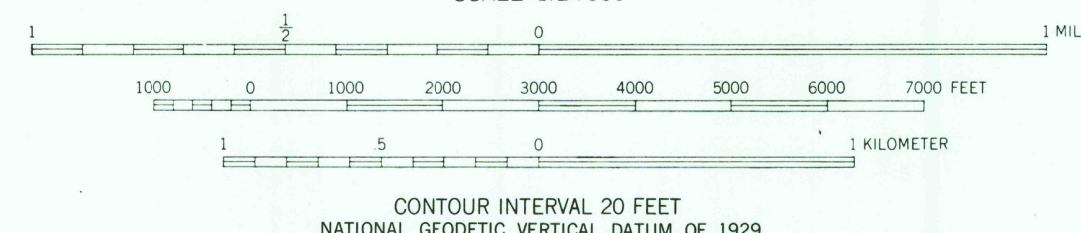

Topography from aerial photographs by multiplex methods. Aerial photographs taken 1947 and 1949. Field check 1953. Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, east central zone. Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue.

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 8 meters north and 51 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
