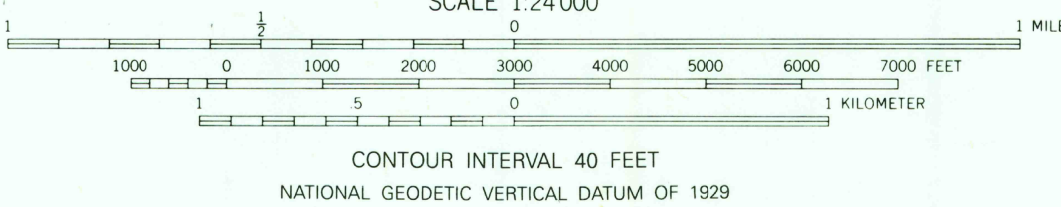
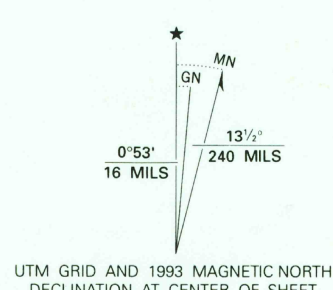

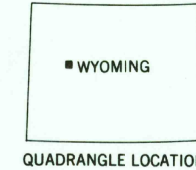
GANNETT PEAK QUADRANGLE
