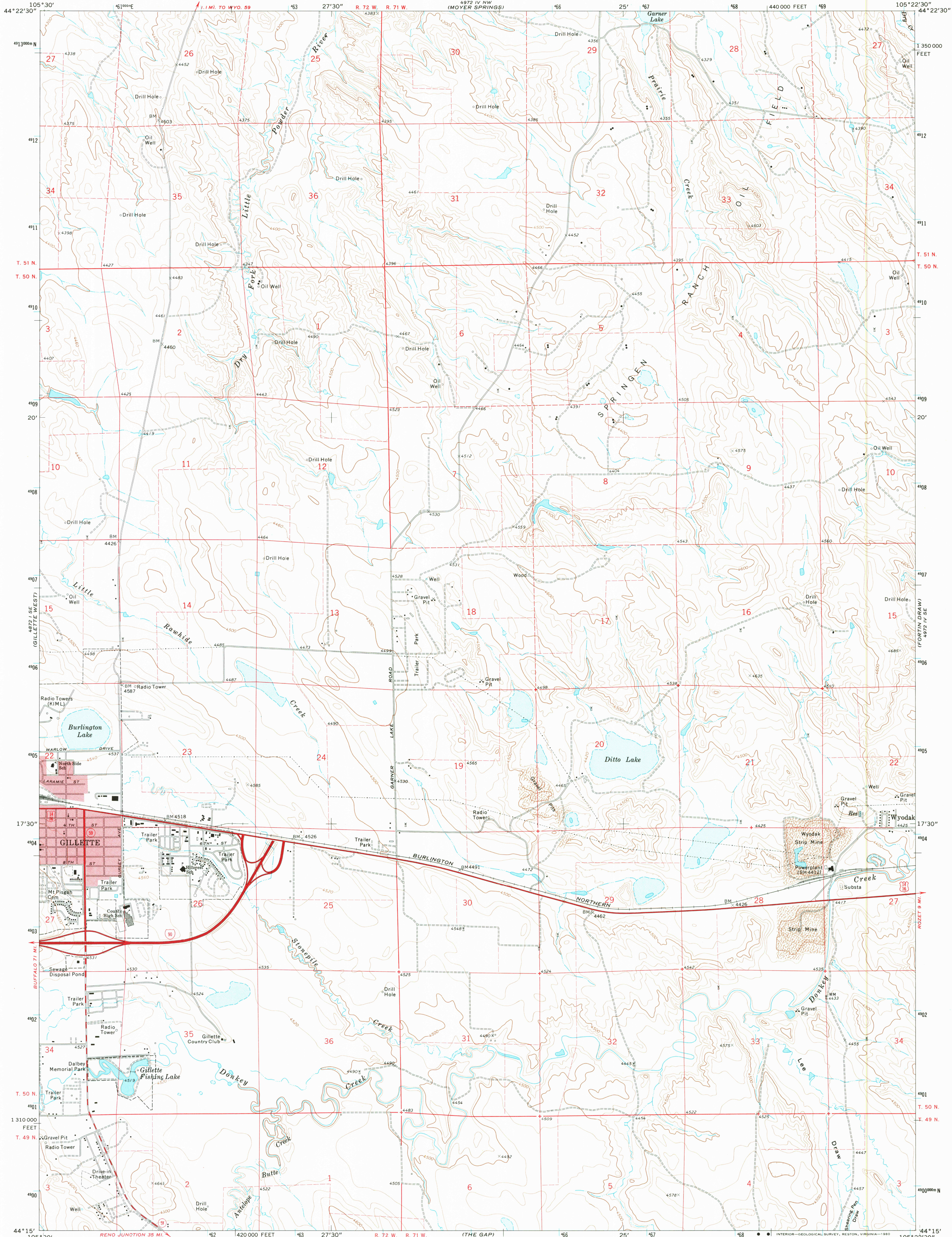

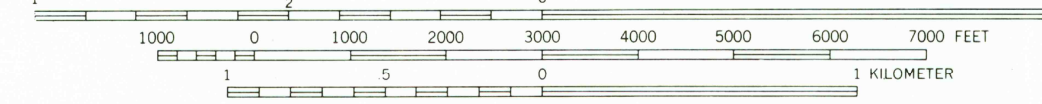
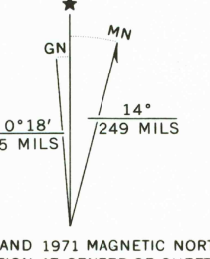

zone 13, shown in blue. 1927 North American datum

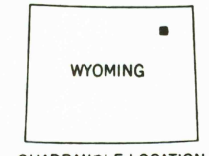
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark features are shown
