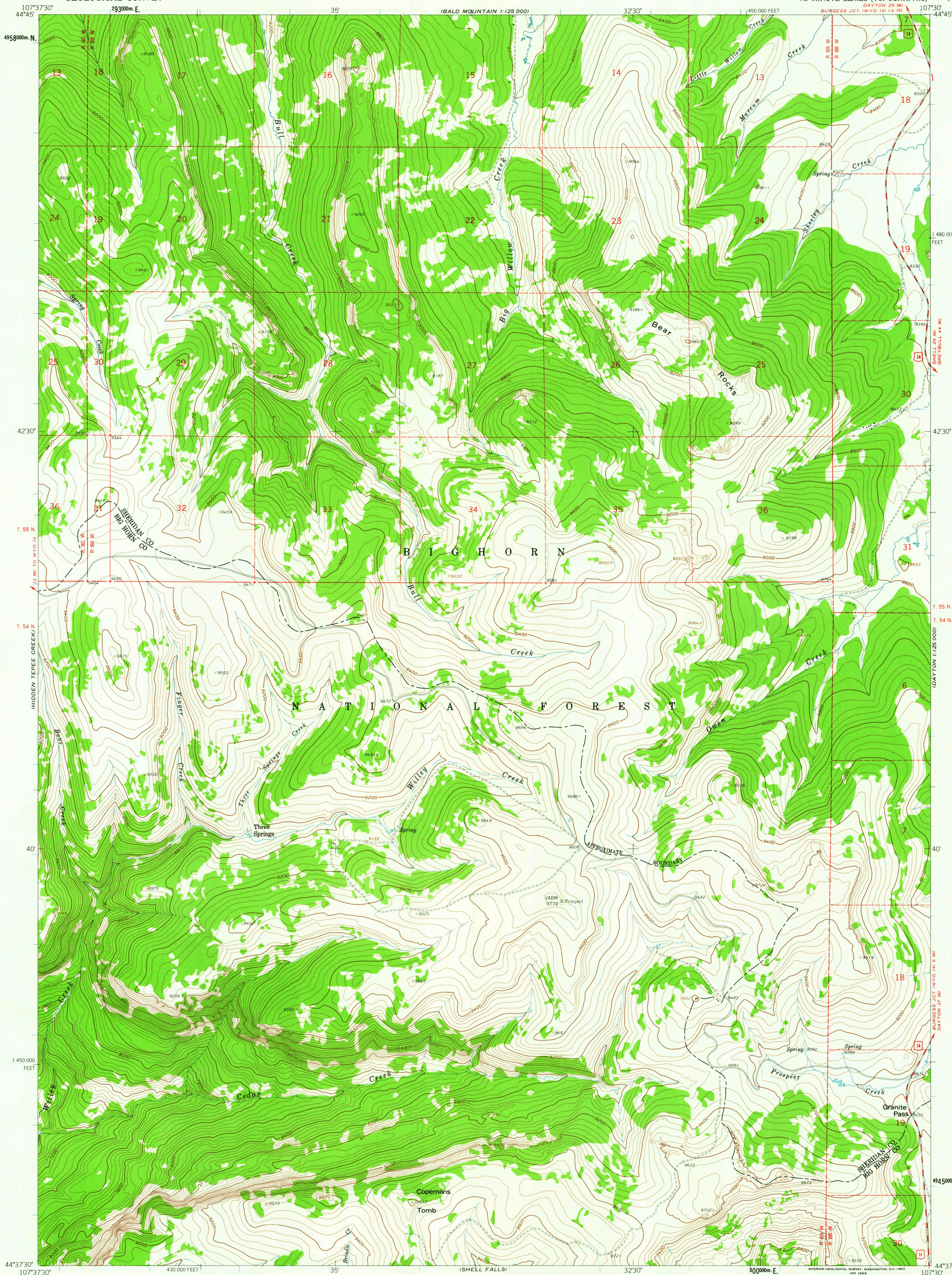

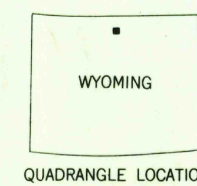
GRANITE PASS QUADRANGLE
