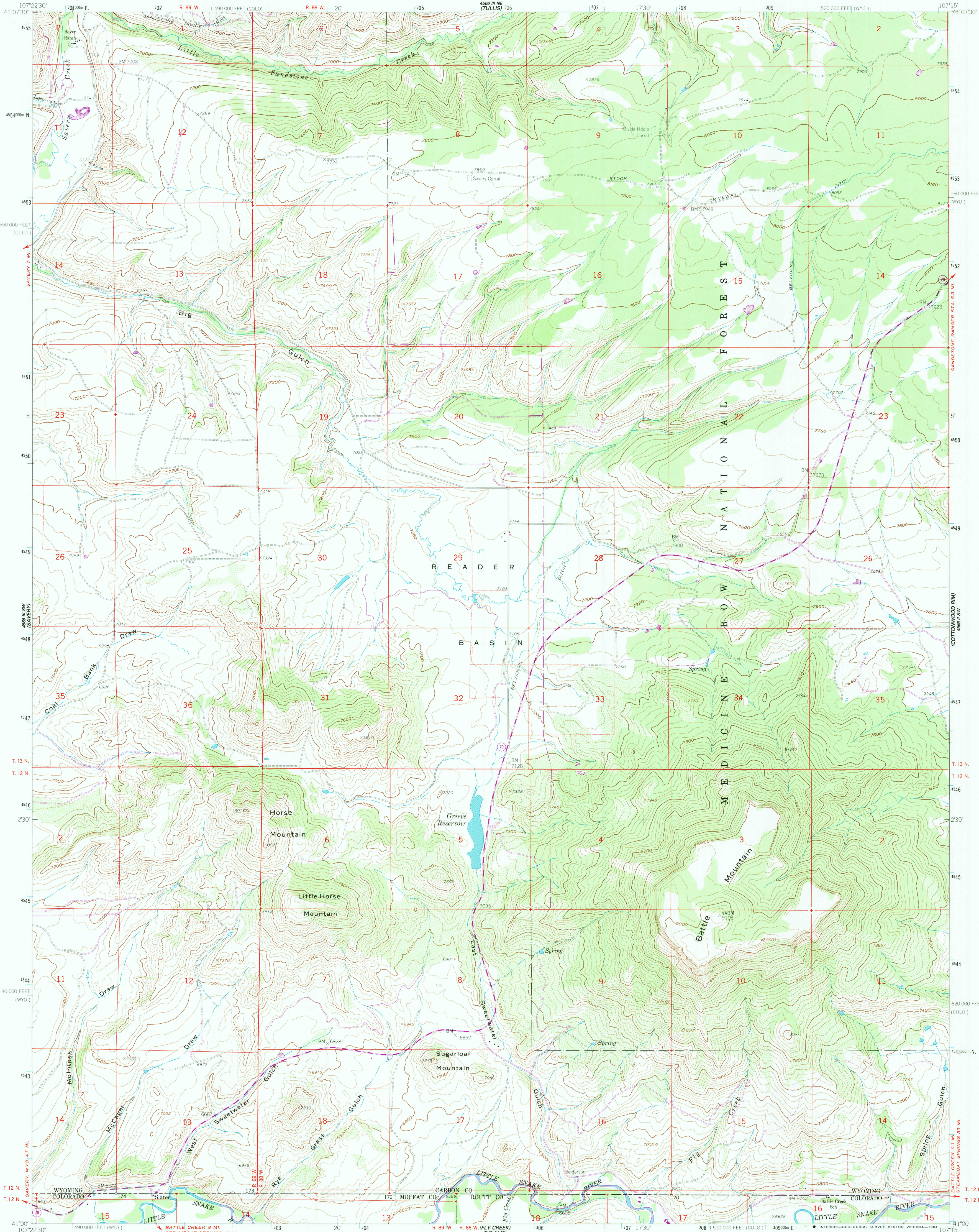

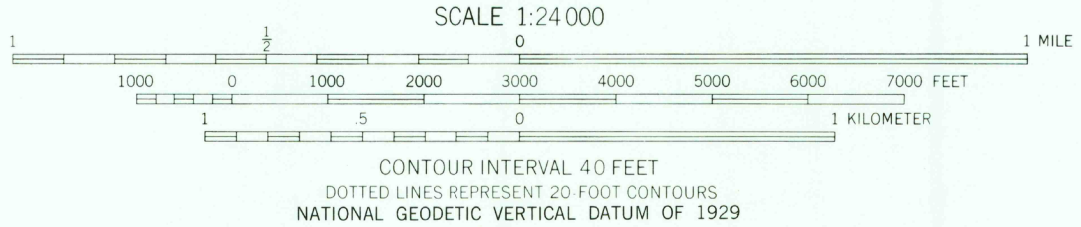
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1957. Field checked 1961.

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.

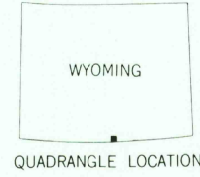
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 7 meters north and 52 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
