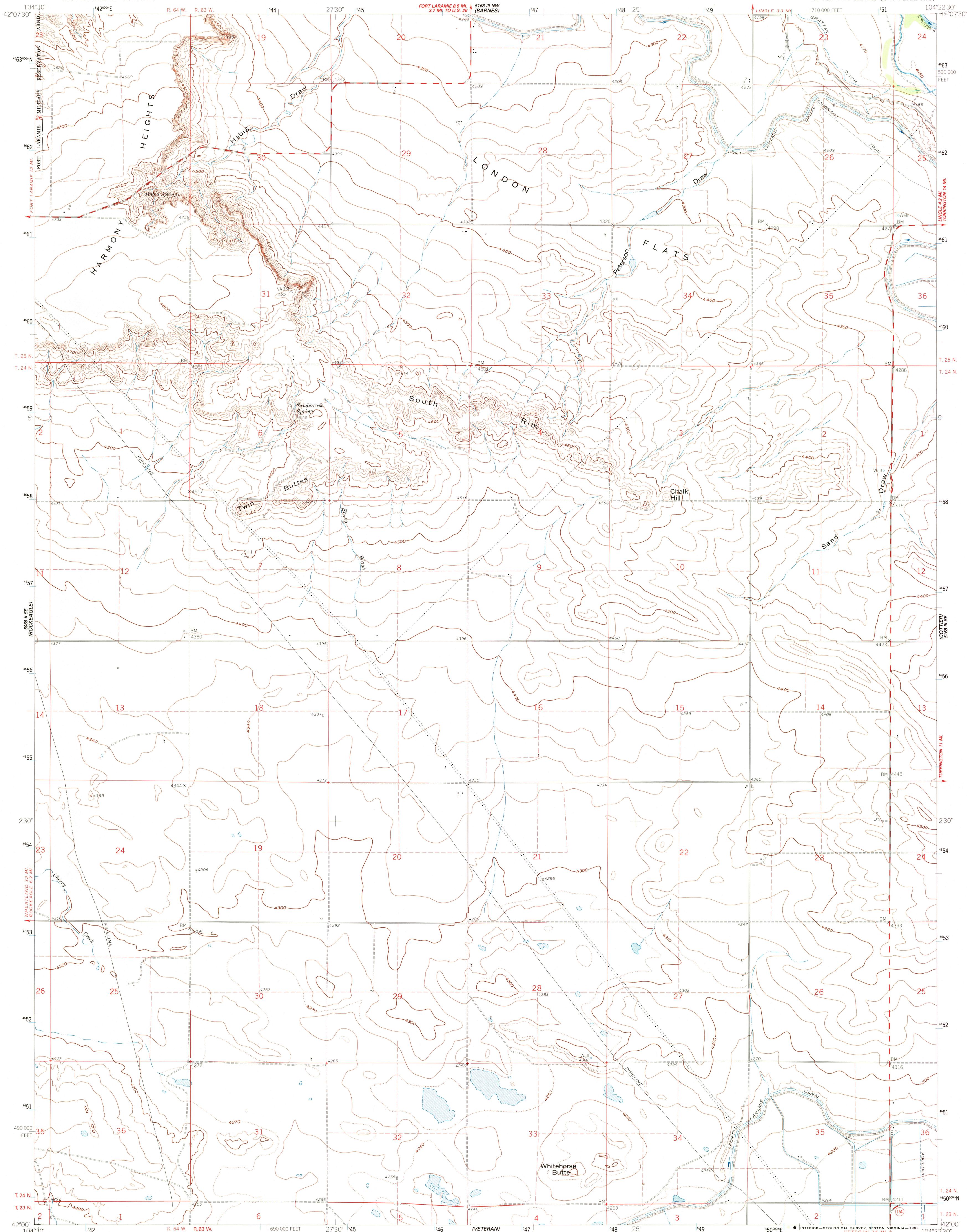
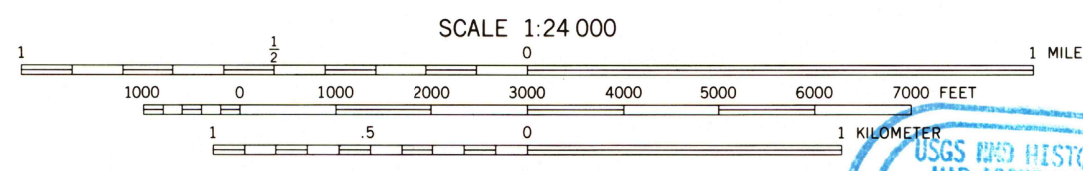
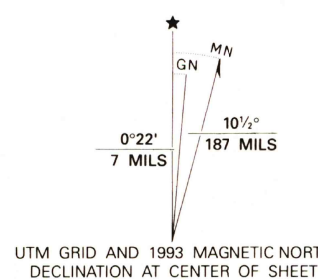

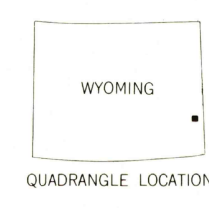
HABIG SPRING QUADRANGLE

Projection and 10000-foot grid ticks: Wyoming Coordinate System, east zone (Transverse Mercator). 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue. The difference between NAD 27 and North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) for 7.5 minute intersections is given in USGS Bulletin 1875. The NAD 83 is shown by dashed corner ticks. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines. Certain land lines are omitted because of insufficient data. Photosinspected from 1991 source; no major culture or drainage changes observed.
