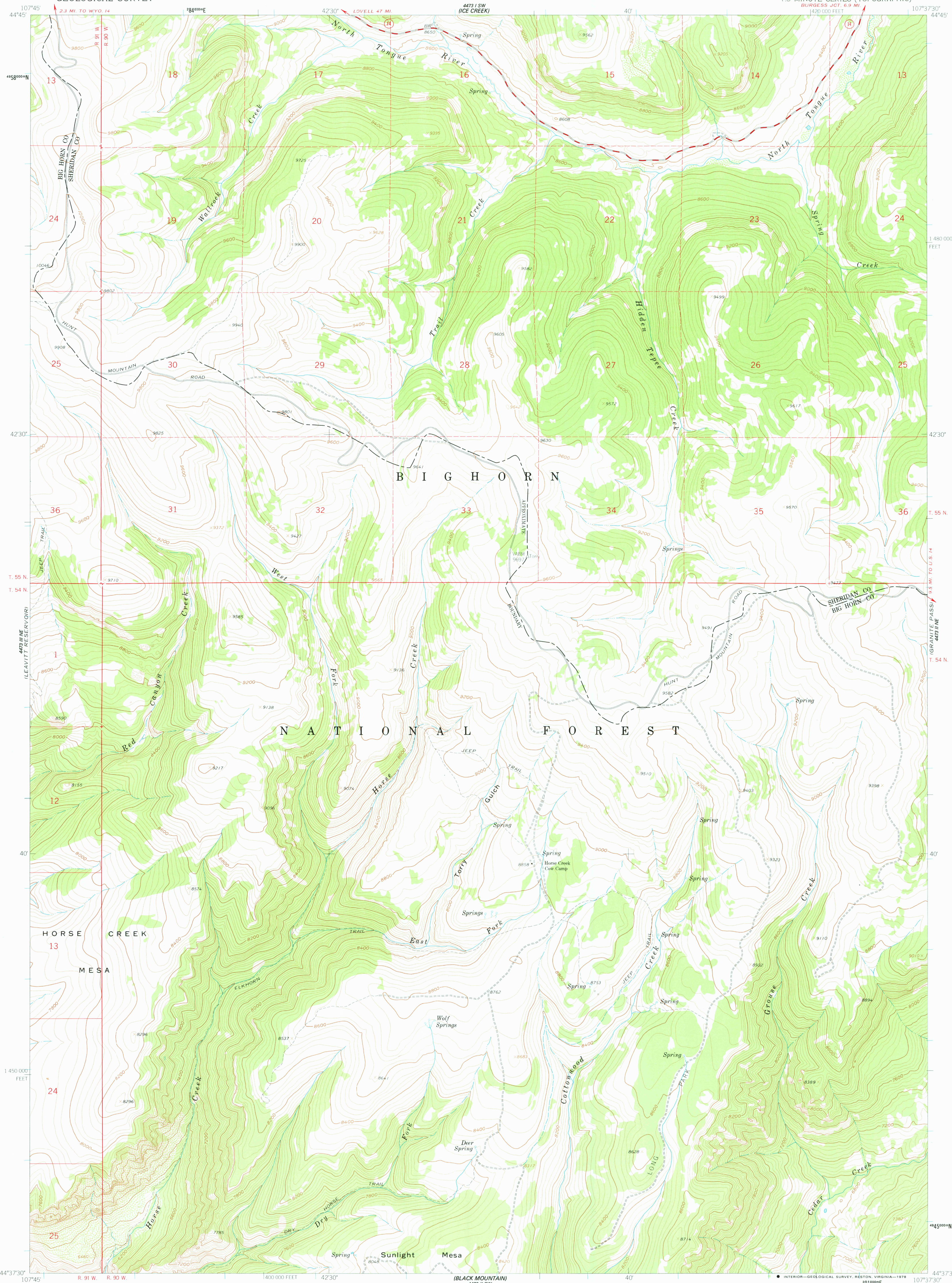
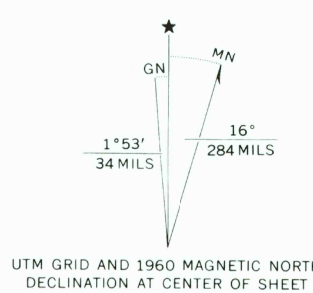

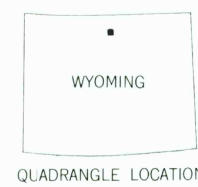
HIDDEN TEEPEE CREEK QUADRANGLE
