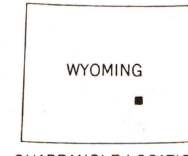
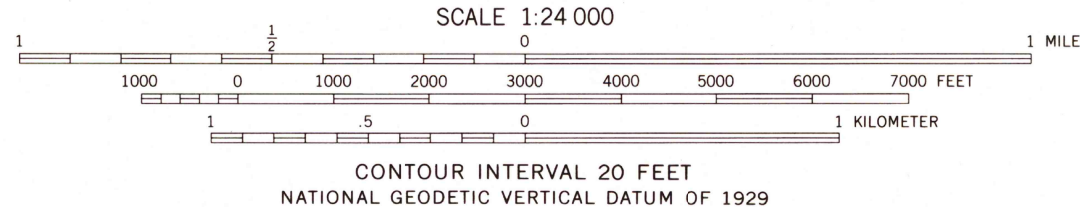
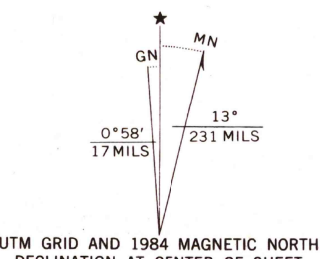
HORSE PEAK QUADRANGLE
