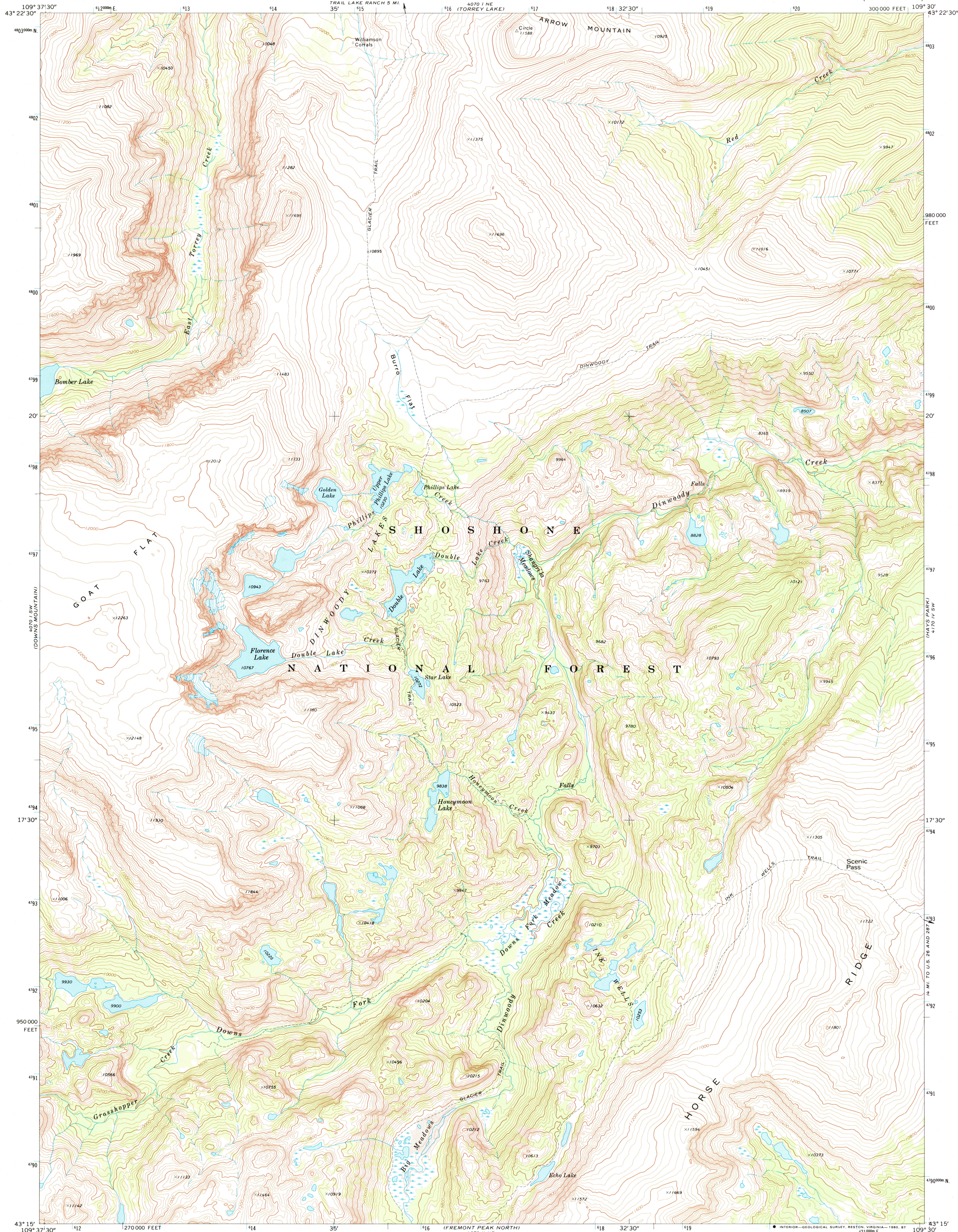

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue

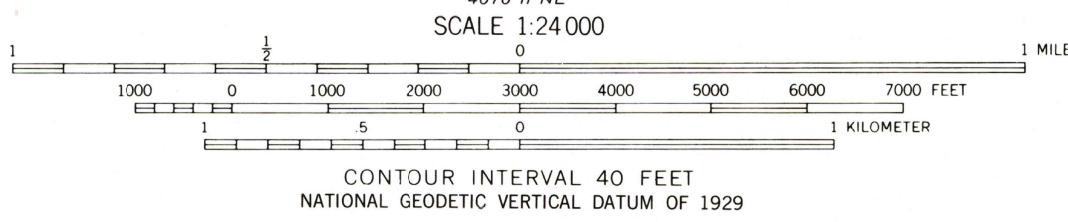
Land lines have not been established in this area

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 10 meters north and 58 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

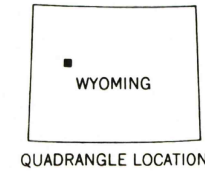
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
