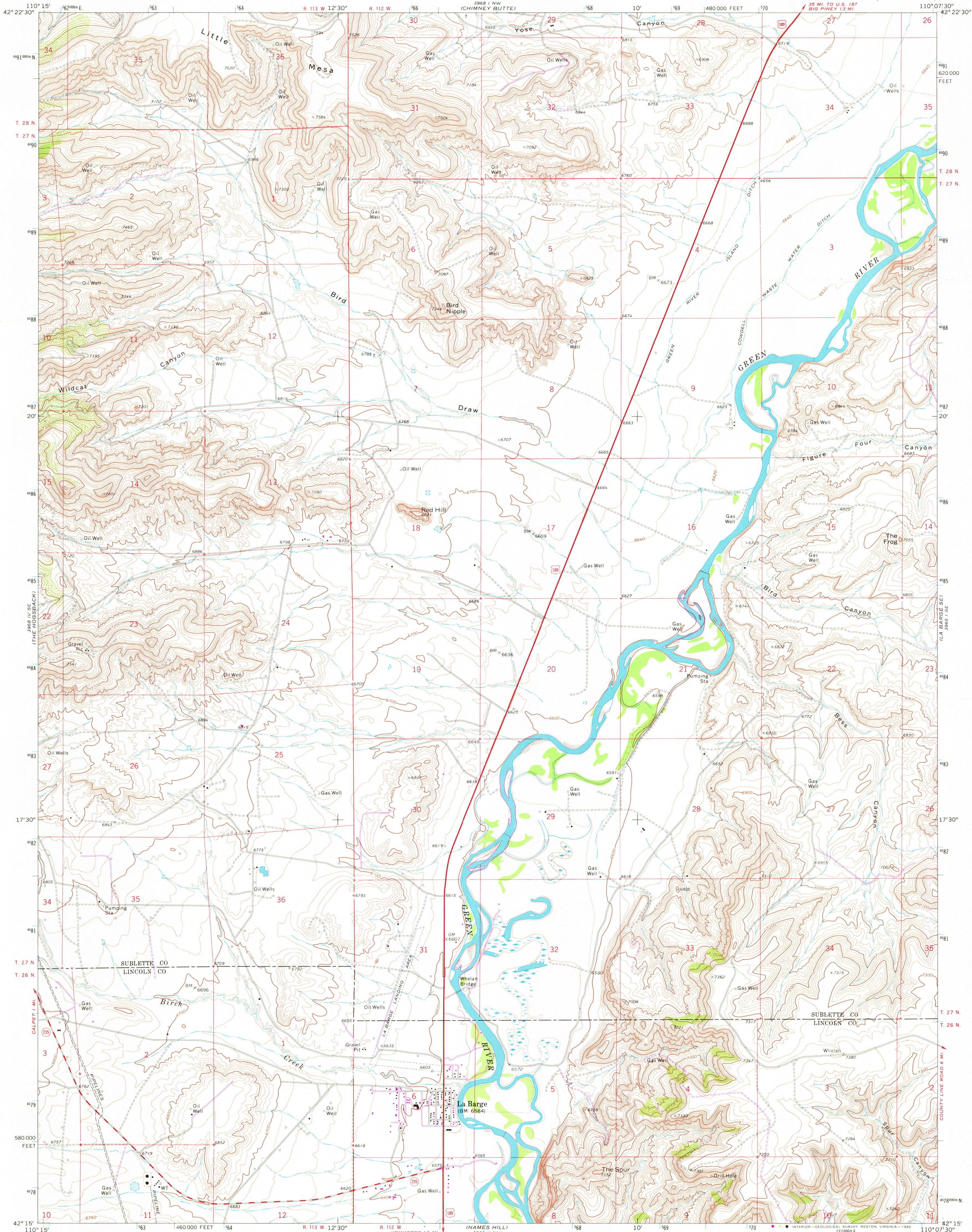

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, west zone

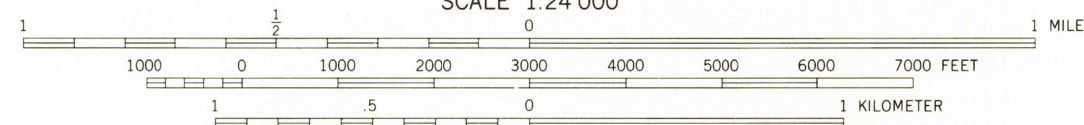
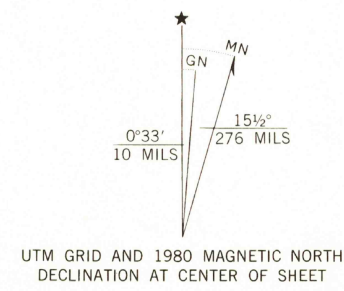
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue

Revisions shown in purple compiled from aerial photographs taken 1978. Map edited 1980. This information not field checked



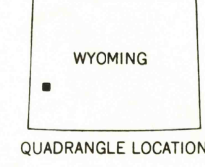
