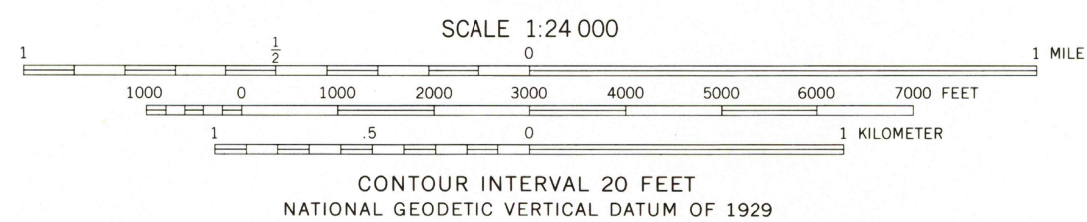
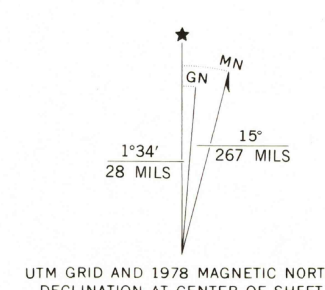

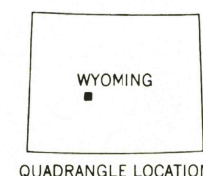

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations. Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown.
