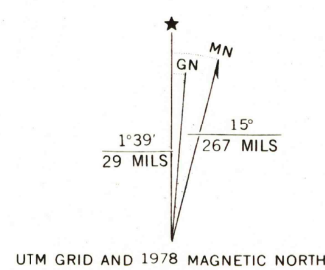

Revisions shown in purple compiled from aerial photographs taken 1975. Map edited 1978. This information not field checked.



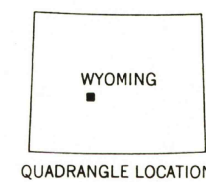
