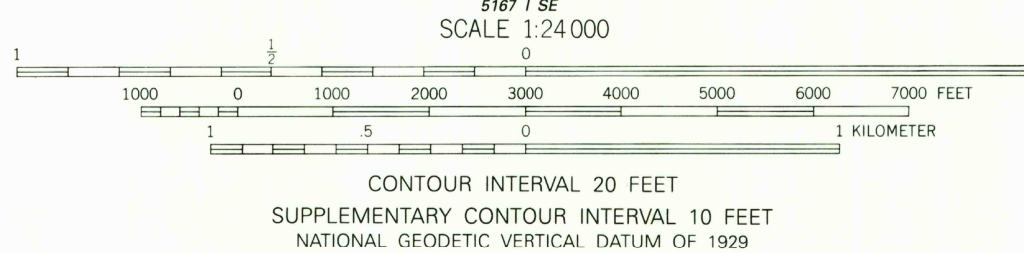
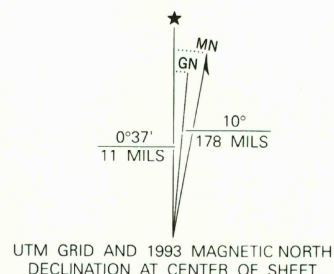

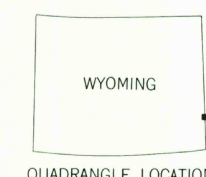
LYMAN QUADRANGLE
