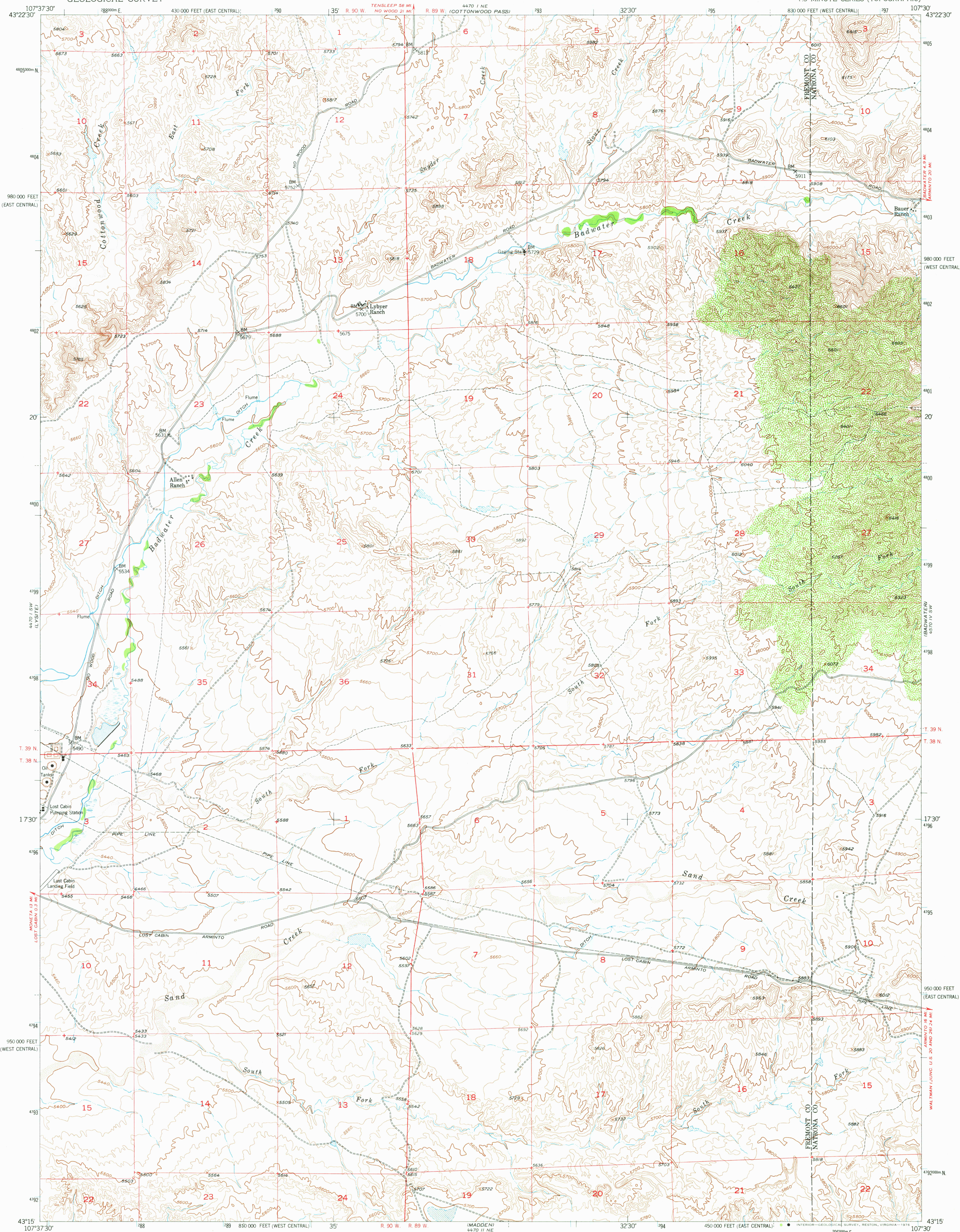

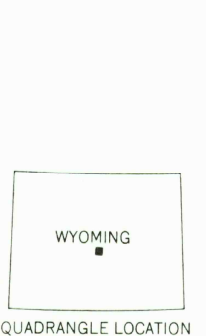
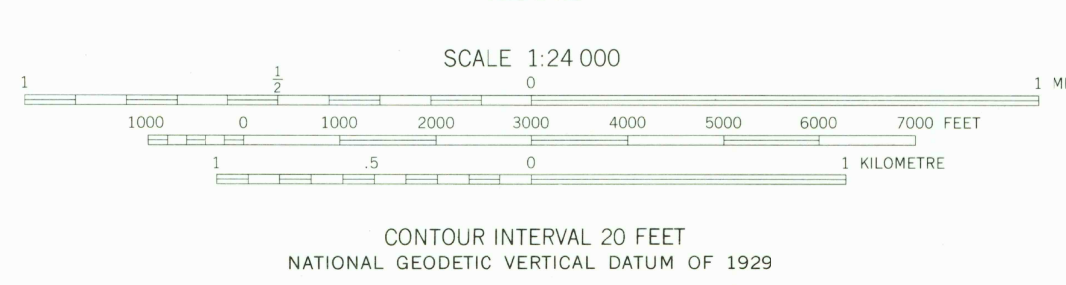
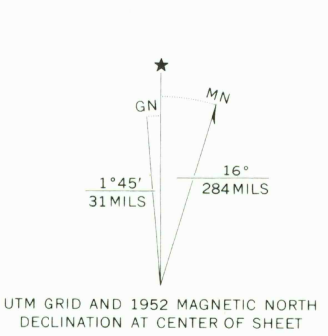
Topography from aerial photographs by multiplex methods. Aerial photographs taken 1949. Field check 1952.
